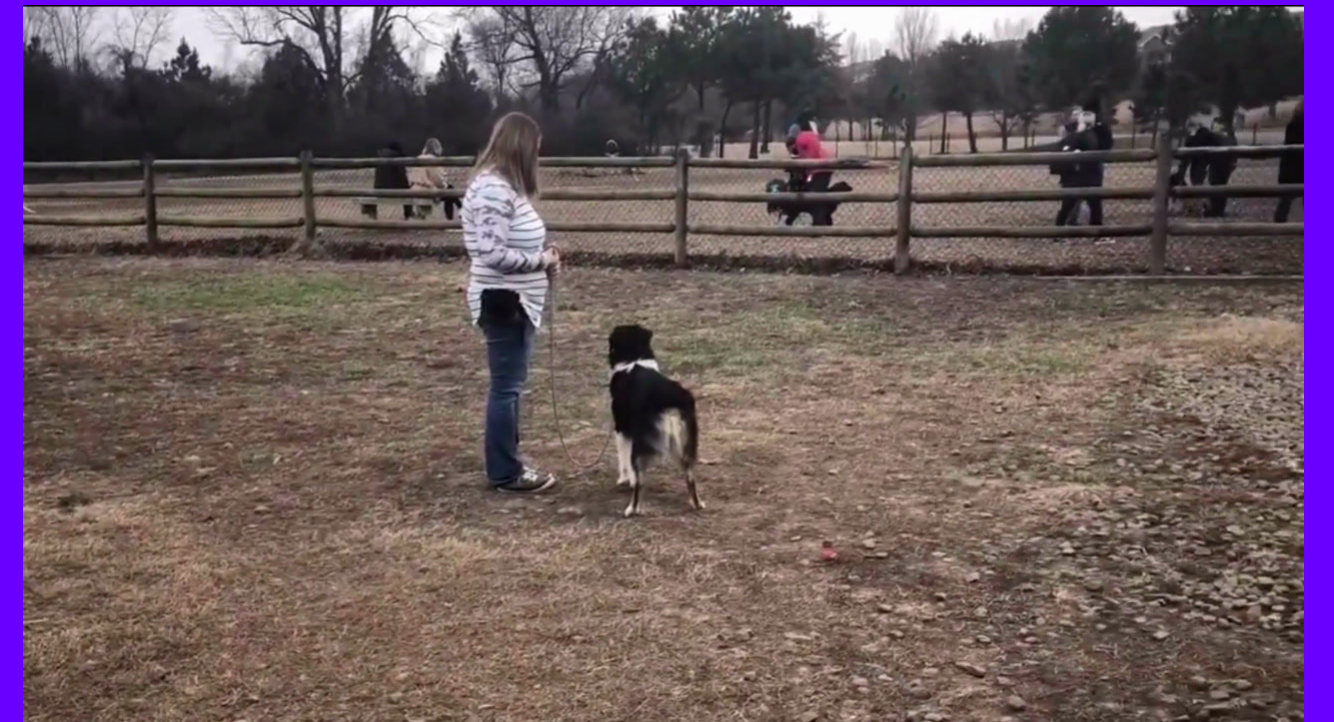
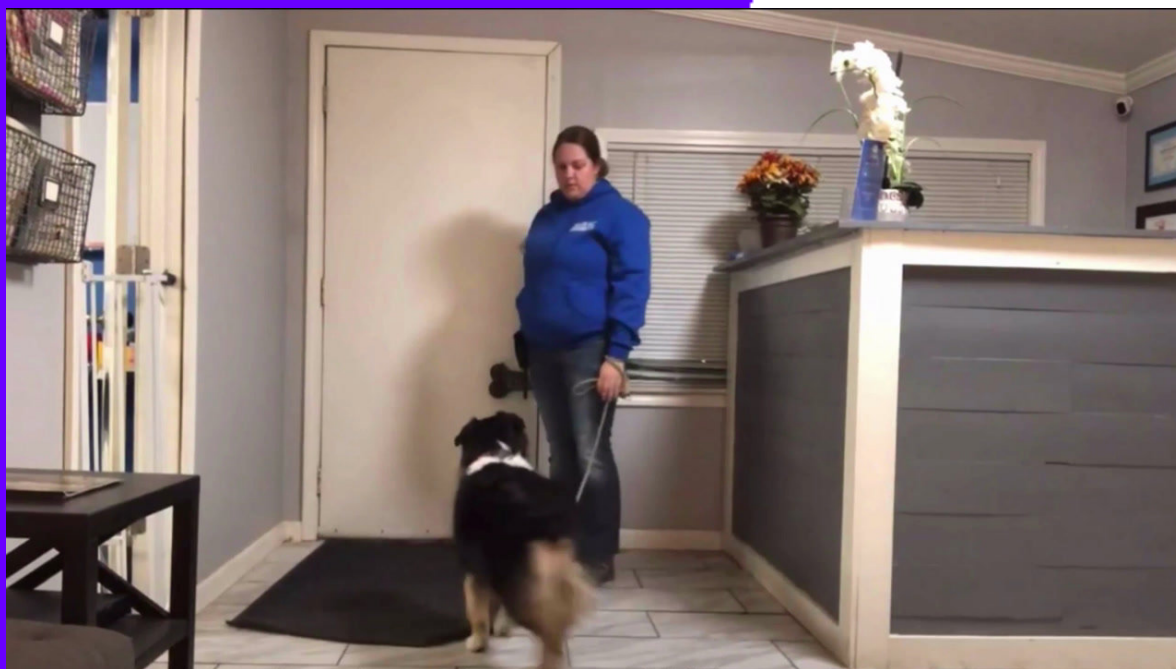
**Skills you learned in the Freshman Course that you will want to make sure you are ready to add layers to in the Sophomore Course**

For focus work, your dog should be able to check in with you in public, look at distractions and check in with you after, check in with you after going through doorways, check in when people approach and should also know how to hand target

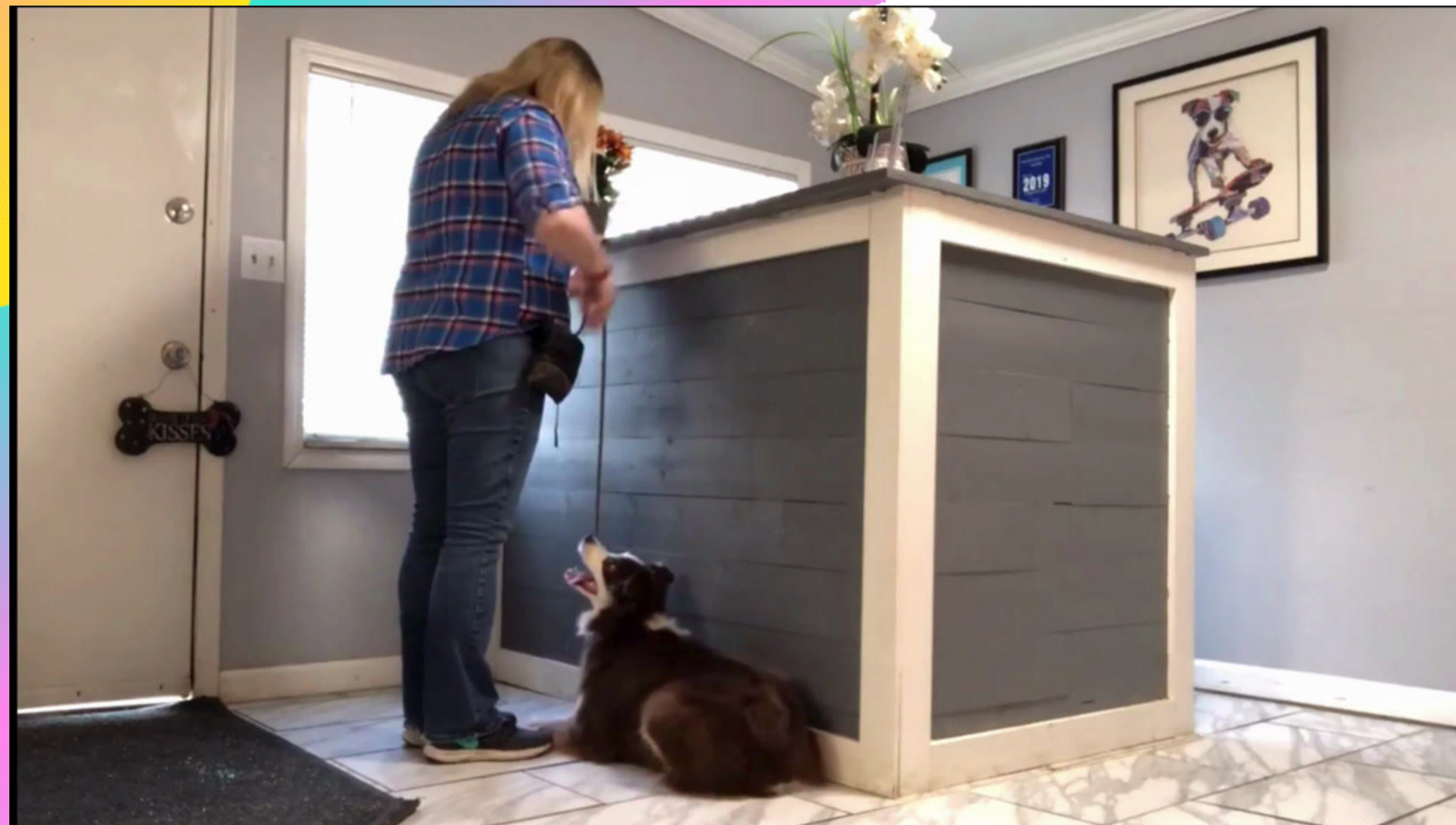

**Sit**



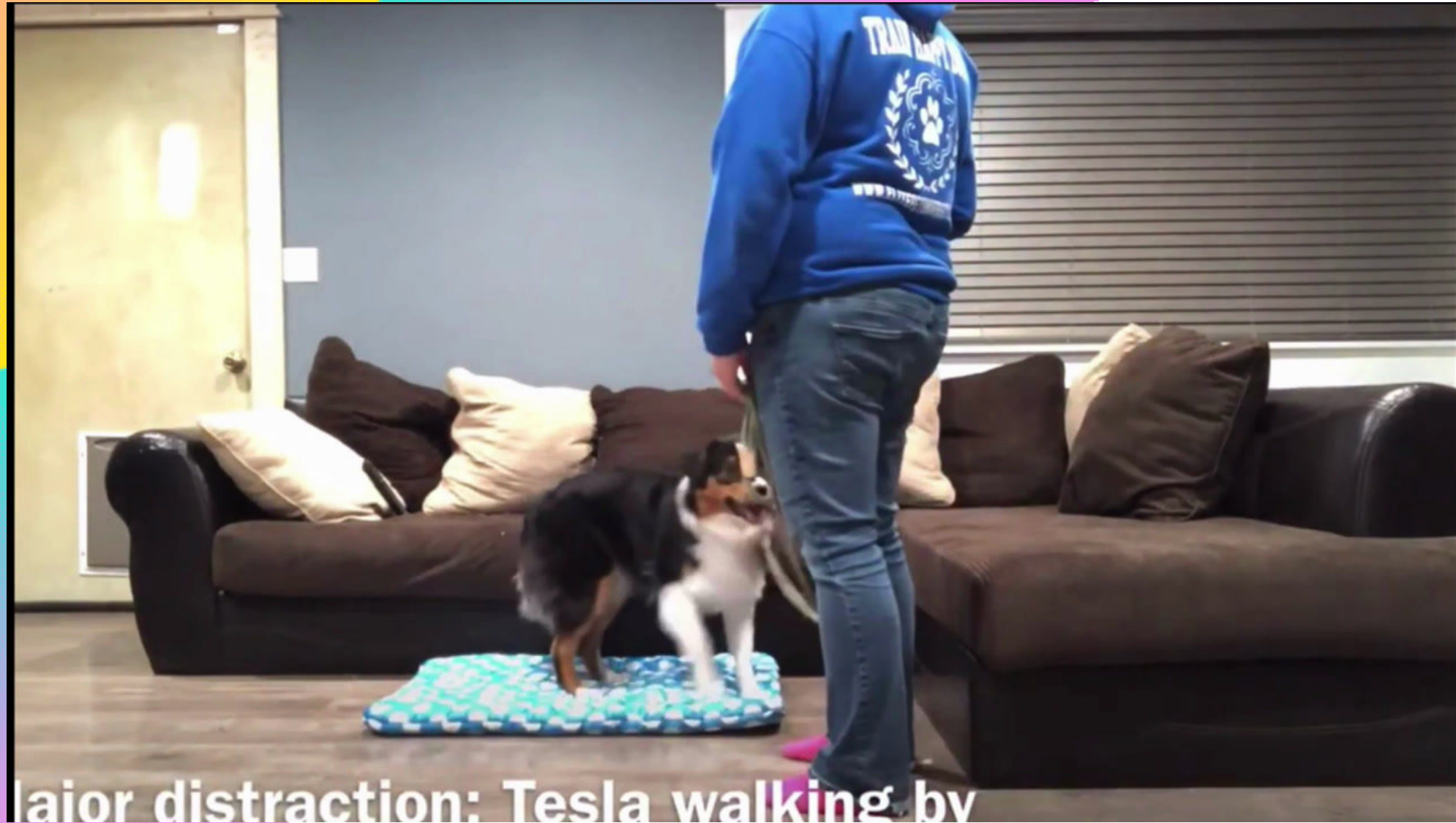
**Down**

# Impulse Control Games





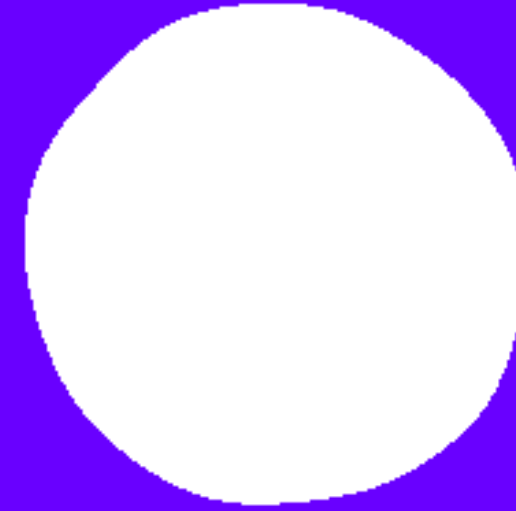
Major distraction: Tesla walking by
