



Single Crochet Stitch

Overview & Homework

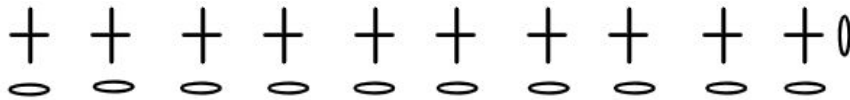
Chain (ch)

- Yarn over hook, draw yarn through loop on hook



Single Crochet (sc)

- Insert hook into stitch, yarn over hook, pull through stitch, yarn over hook, pull through 2 loops on hook



- **Tip 1:** Hook should be facing downward (not sideways or up)
- **Tip 2:** Hold last chain / stitch before you create the next; holds work steady
- **Tip 3:** Stitches become uniform with practice; don't worry about the look just yet, focus on the action and counting.



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Single Crochet - Practice Swatch Pattern

Note: Use stitch markers to mark the top of the first stitch in each row (as noted in pattern).

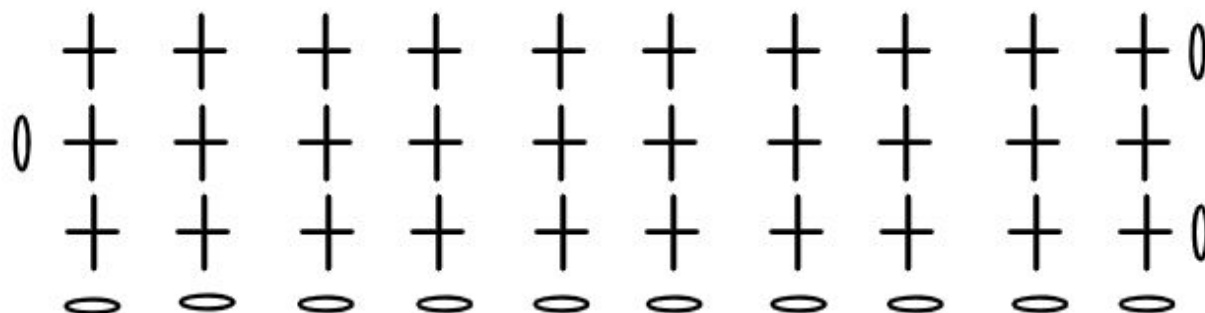
INSTRUCTIONS

Form Slip Knot, Ch 11

Row 1: Skip 1 chain (not a stitch), Single Crochet into 2nd Chain from hook (place stitch marker into top of stitch), work 1 Single Crochet into each Chain across - **10 Single Crochet**

Row 2: Chain 1 (not a stitch), turn, Single Crochet into first stitch (place stitch marker into top of stitch), work 1 Single Crochet into each Stitch across - **10 Single Crochet**

Repeat Row 2 until 10 Rows are complete, fasten off.





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
