FABRIC CIGAR BOX DIY KIT

OR

START FROM SCRATCH

This DIY cartonnage Kit comes with all paperboard you need to make your Fabric Cigar Box. The pieces are precut in the correct sizes you need for this project. [Click here to shop](#) the 2 sizes available (find coupon code inside the course):

- Chipboard (100 points): 1 sheet 14" x 11"
- Paper cutter

- Poster board : 1 sheet – around 22" x 28"
(find at Dollar Tree / Walmart / Hobby Lobby)

- Fabric (quilting fabric – 100% cotton): 2 coordinating fat quarters
(avoid solid plain fabric (like Kona Cotton) – if fussy cutting you will need extra fabric)
Note: 1 fat quarter is half of a half yard – 18" x 22"

- Glue All (from Elmer's). NOTE: It is not "School Glue", It is [Glue All](#).

OTHER MATERIALS AND TOOLS:

- Masking tape
- Rotary cutter and cutting mat
- Scissors / ruler
- Craft knife/metal ruler or other paper cutter
(if not using DIY kit)
- Roller paint/paint brush
- Heavy book

- Cartonnage tools (corner miter tool and plastic spatula).
- Scrap of paper to cover the table
- Wet wipes/ dry scrap of cloth
- Optional: Small knob or handle (with screws ,
screwdriver and hole punch) / waxed cotton thread
