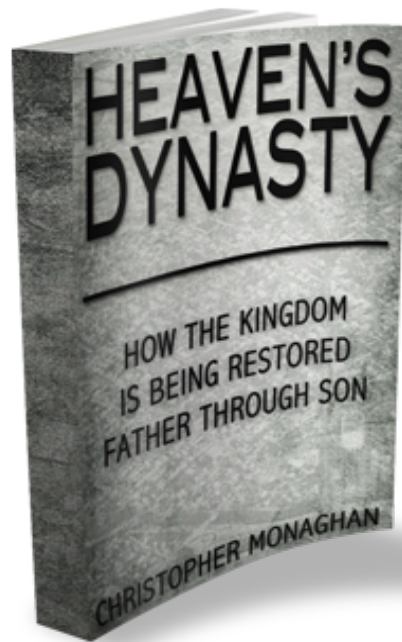
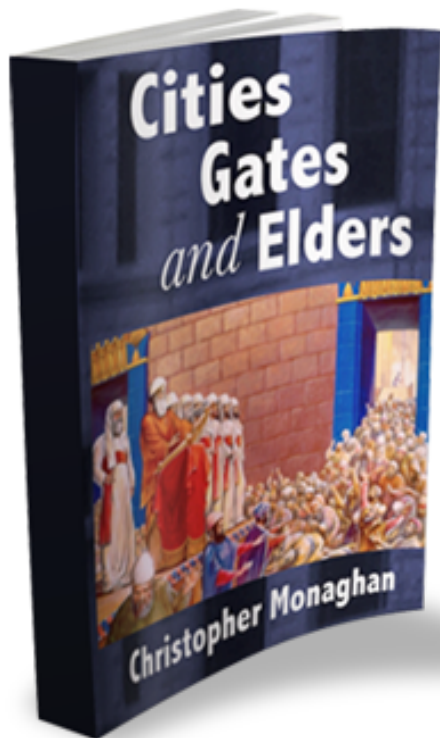


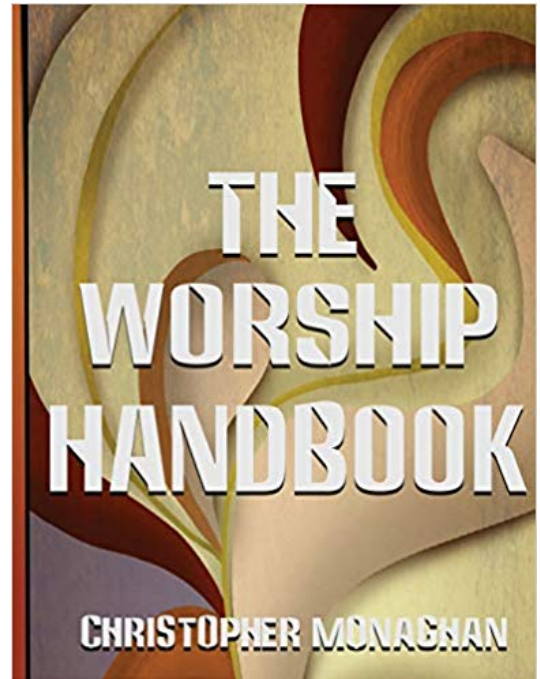
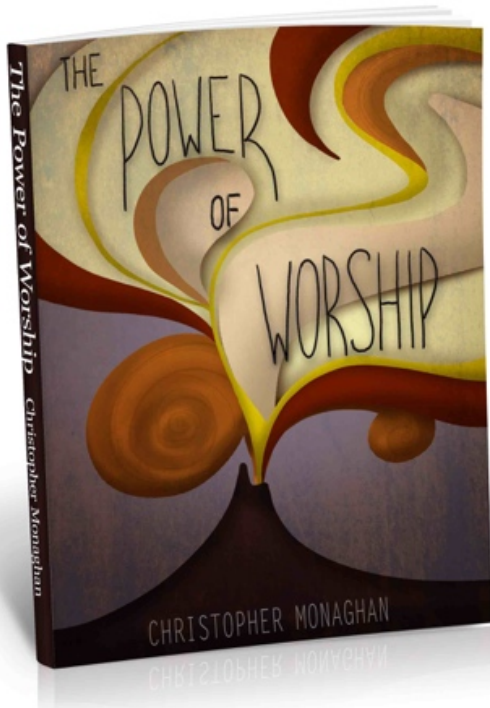
# Other Resources
