EXECUTIVE PROTECTION

- ASIS International defines executive protection as the field of safeguarding a key person from harm.
- Key Person (At Risk Person)
 - Celebrity
 - Elected official
 - Corporate executive or CEO
 - High ranking military official
 - Faith-based leader





MODERN EXECUTIVE PROTECTION: HISTORY

• United States Secret Service (USSS): 1865

- 1894: Informal presidential protection for President Cleveland
- 1902: USSS assumed full-time responsibility for protecting the U.S. President





MODERN EXECUTIVE PROTECTION: HISTORY

• Corporate Interest in Executive Protection: 1970s

- Terrorism and kidnappings
 - 09/05/1977: Hans Martin Schleyer
 - Red Army Faction (RAF)
 - Extensive planning and pre-attack surveillance
 - Murdered (ambush): security driver and three police officers (escort)










EXECUTIVE PROTECTION: CATEGORIES

• Public Sector Protection

- Taxpayer-funded
- Mandated
- Overt or direct protection
- Medium to high threat environments
- Armed personnel
- Enhanced arrest authority
 - LLEA, U.S. Government










EXECUTIVE PROTECTION: CATEGORIES

• Private Sector Protection

- Privately funded
- Board driven
- Indirect or low profile
- Low threat environments
- Unarmed personnel
- Private citizens: licensing required









CERTIFICATION IN EXECUTIVE PROTECTION: PRIVATE SECTOR

- No national standard or certification for executive protection
- State regulated
- Security officer training and certification
