

# GLOSSARY OF SAP EVENT MANAGEMENT

# A Quick Reference Guide to SAP Terminologies



| Concept/Term                     | Definition   |
|----------------------------------|--|
| SAP Event Management (SAP<br>EM) | A module that provides visibility into end-<br>to-end supply chain processes. Tracks and<br>manages events and exceptions in real<br>time. |
| Event                            | A specific occurrence or activity in a business process that can be tracked and managed in SAP EM.   |
| Event Handler                    | A logical object in SAP EM that groups related events together. It serves as the central point for managing event-related data.            |
| Event Type                       | Defines the nature or category of an event. Examples include delivery, shipment, or production-related events.                             |
| Event Monitoring                 | The process of tracking and analyzing events in real-time to ensure that business processes proceed as expected.                           |



| Concept/Term         | Definition  |
|----------------------|---|
| Exception Management | A process in SAP EM for handling disruptions or deviations from planned activities. Includes notifications and corrective actions.  |
| Tracking and Tracing | The process of monitoring the status of goods or processes. SAP EM provides detailed tracking across different stages of logistics. |
| Status Management    | Defines the current state of a process or event, such as "in progress" or "completed." Used to monitor and manage workflows.        |
| Event Notification   | A message sent to users or systems that alerts them to the occurrence of a defined event or exception.                              |
| Event Handler Status | The current status of an event handler, such as open, completed, or closed.   |



| Concept/Term                         | Definition  |
|--------------------------------------|---|
| SAP Global Track and Trace<br>(GT&T) | A solution integrated with SAP EM for global tracking and monitoring of shipments, providing real-time visibility.        |
| SAP Event Management<br>Cockpit      | A central interface in SAP EM for monitoring and managing events and exceptions. Provides dashboards and reporting.       |
| Event Capture                        | The process of capturing event data from external systems, such as transportation or warehouse management systems.        |
| Business Transaction                 | A specific business action or process, such as shipping a product or receiving an order, that can be tracked as an event. |
| Event Management<br>Workbench        | A tool used to configure, manage, and monitor event handlers, events, and exceptions within SAP EM.                       |



| Concept/Term              | Definition  |

| Event Handler Monitoring  | The process of reviewing and analyzing event handler data to ensure that events are being tracked correctly.                  |
| Event Management Workflow | A defined sequence of steps for handling events and exceptions, ensuring that necessary actions are taken in a timely manner. |
| Exception Trigger         | A condition that automatically activates exception handling in SAP EM when an event deviates from the planned process.        |
| Alert Management          | A system that generates alerts for users or systems based on predefined criteria, such as event or exception status.          |
| Tracking Object           | An object that represents the entity being tracked, such as a shipment, delivery, or production batch, in SAP EM.             |



| Concept/Term                                 | Definition  |
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| SAP Advanced Planning and Optimization (APO) | A tool for supply chain planning that can be integrated with SAP EM for tracking and managing events in the supply chain.                     |
| Event Handler Template                       | A pre-configured template for defining event handlers, used to standardize event management processes.  |
| Event Subscription                           | A method for subscribing to specific events or event handlers, allowing users to receive notifications about specific changes or occurrences. |
| SAP Supply Chain<br>Management (SCM)         | An SAP suite that integrates with SAP EM to provide end-to-end visibility into supply chain events and processes.                             |
| Delivery Event                               | An event that tracks the status of goods during delivery. Includes monitoring for delays or exceptions during transit.                        |

## SAP Event Management Key Concepts



| Concept/Term         | Definition   |
|----------------------|--|
| Production Event     | An event that monitors the status of production processes, including milestones such as production start, end, and quality checks. |
| Warehouse Event      | A logistics-related event that tracks the movement of goods within a warehouse, including goods receipt, putaway, and picking.     |
| Order Event          | Tracks the status of customer orders, including stages such as order creation, shipment, and delivery.                             |
| Custom Event Type    | A user-defined event type in SAP EM, allowing businesses to track unique events specific to their processes.                       |
| Event Handling Rules | Configurations that define how specific events or exceptions should be handled, including escalation or corrective actions.        |



| Concept/Term                    | Definition  |
|---------------------------------|---|
| Event Management<br>Integration | The integration of SAP EM with other SAP modules, such as SAP ERP, SAP WM, or SAP TM, to enable seamless event tracking across processes.           |
| Event Creation                  | The process of manually or automatically generating events in SAP EM based on system data or external triggers.                                     |
| Event History                   | A record of past events and their statuses, used for auditing, reporting, and historical tracking.  |
| Exception Handling Workflow     | A workflow that dictates the actions taken when an exception is detected, such as notifying a manager or triggering an automated corrective action. |
| Event Handler Search            | A tool used to search for specific event handlers, providing insights into event statuses and exceptions.   |



## SAP Event Management Key Concepts



| Concept/Term                      | Definition   |
|-----------------------------------|--|
| Event Documentation               | The detailed records associated with an event, including timestamps, statuses, and any actions taken during the event.                           |
| Tracking Query                    | A query in SAP EM that allows users to search and filter event data based on various parameters like date, status, or event type.                |
| Event and Exception Reporting     | The process of generating reports based on event and exception data, providing insights into supply chain performance and disruptions.           |
| Event Dashboard                   | A real-time visualization tool that displays key event and exception metrics, helping managers monitor and address issues quickly.               |
| Cross-System Event<br>Integration | The process of integrating event data from multiple systems (e.g., warehouse management, transportation) into SAP EM for comprehensive tracking. |



| Concept/Term         | Definition  |
|----------------------|---|
| Event Business Logic | The rules and conditions that define how events are triggered, processed, and resolved within SAP EM.                                     |
| Event Triggers       | The conditions or actions that cause an event to occur, such as a change in inventory or the completion of a shipment.                    |
| Event Messaging      | The process of sending messages about event occurrences to users or other systems, providing alerts or updates about important events.    |
| Event Resolution     | The process of managing and resolving exceptions or issues identified during event tracking, such as delays or damages.                   |
| Event Lifecycle      | The sequence of stages through which an event passes, from creation through resolution, including all related status updates and actions. |



## SAP Event Management Key Concepts



| Concept/Term                          | Definition   |
|---------------------------------------|--|
| SAP Transportation<br>Management (TM) | An SAP solution that integrates with SAP EM to provide end-to-end visibility and management of transportation events.            |
| SAP Event Management API              | An application programming interface that allows for external systems to interact with SAP EM, sending and receiving event data. |
| Event-Based Monitoring                | A method of system monitoring that focuses on tracking key events and exceptions, rather than continuous monitoring.             |
| Event Reporting                       | The creation of detailed reports on events and their statuses, often used for analysis and continuous improvement of operations. |
| Real-Time Event Processing            | The ability to process and respond to events as they occur, providing immediate insights into supply chain activities.           |
