Attitudinal

After taking this course and applying the truths revealed with revelation from God Himself, you may and will want to recognize changes that are taking place in your attitudes.

Behavioral

Seek true, honest, and pure worship of God.

Allow God to be sovereign and Lord of every area of your life, so that you will know and walk in the righteousness of Jesus Christ.

Be determined to trust and rest in God as He is all-knowing, all-powerful, and always present.

Ask God to give you revelation of His love, compassion, and favor for you.

Turn to God more quickly for your every need.

Submit to God as Deliverer, Teacher, and Guide for your life.

Glorify and give pleasure to God.

 2. Journal about the Scripture verses as you meditate on them Also journal about the attributes and names of God as you go through this course. Listen to what God wants to tell you about Himself and your relationship with Him.
 3. Complete self-tests as given.
 4. Write a paper due on the last class of the semester. In this paper, discuss what the Lord has shown you through your meditation and journaling on the Scripture passages, the attributes of God, and the Names of God. Be succinct in bringing together the truths and revelations the Lord has shown you. Your paper This should be a minimum of 3 pages and a maximum of 5 pages in length, double spaced, with a 12 point font.

 - El Roi - The God Who Sees
 - El Shaddai - The All-Sufficient One
 - Adonai - The LORD
 - surrender to God more quickly as you grow in trust of Him.

Pray and meditate on the scripture verse Philippians 4:19.

Objectives:

- discuss the meaning and significance to you of these Names of the Lord:
 - Jehovah - The Self-Existent One
 - Jehovah-jireh - The Lord Will Provide
 - contrast the meanings of LORD (Jehovah) and the Lord (Adonai).
 - deepen your trust in God.

Pray and meditate on the scripture verse Exodus 15:26.

- discuss the meaning and significance to you of these Names of the Lord:
 - Jehovah-rapha - The Lord Who Heals
