BROKENNESS: GEN. 25: 26-32:32


- Natural leaders don't have it easy always.

NATURAL LEADERS OFTEN NEED TO BE BROKEN


 Jacob the deceiving heel – catcher- became Israel, a prince with God, who purpose to serve God rather than himself.

BREAKING BEFORE BLESSING

- Jacob broke physically when the angel dislocated his hip.
- He also broke emotionally- he told the truth about his name and character.
- From that moment on, Jacob began to fulfil his God-ordained destiny.

Jacob was <u>honest</u> with God v 27. He stepped pretending in order to let God work in his life.

Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up. James 4:10




