



- White Phi tile (5x3 inches - 8x13cm). You can also use a larger size rectangle of any dimension. If cutting your own rectangle, use white card stock paper or watercolor paper.
- Colored card stock rectangle, measuring 5-1/4x3-1/4 inches - 8.5x13.5 cm). This will be the background of the card. Use any color, make sure you have matching markers and fine-liners. This should be about 1/4 inch (0-.5cm) larger than the size of your white card
- Black inking pen. I use Sakura Micron PN or 01.
- Colorful fine-liner matching the background card. I use Stabilo or Marvy Le Pen.
- Graphite pencil. I use Staedtler Mars Lumograph F.
- Colorful markers matching the color of the background card. I use Copic markers but any markers will do.
- White gel pen. I use Sakura Gelly Roll 10.
- Colored pencils in dark colors matching the background card.
- Practice paper or journal
- A pair of sharp, small scissors. I use Olfa Precision Smooth scissors.
- A scoring tool, or an empty ball point pen
- Glue: runner, dots or other. I use a glue runner.
- Optional: Folding bone
