THE SODALITIES OF OUR LADY

In 1563 a Jesuit by the name of Jean Leunis formed a group of young men and instilled in them the importance of establishing the daily Examination of Conscience and monthly confession as an important means towards spiritual growth. The Sodalities of our Lady became a world-wide movement of both women and men, forming millions of lay leaders in the faith and lasted for 400 years.

Watson and the Sacred Story Institute have spent eight years creating the tools of formation and conversion called Sacred Story Community. Sacred Story Community provides means for lay faithful to believe that Christ is present to his people and still working powerfully and miraculously in our lives and in our world.

Sacred Story Community will hold out a model of simple faith and belief in Christ that formed the early Church and that has reformed the Church in every epoch. As such, Sacred Story Community will be under the patronage of The Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Immaculate Heart of Mary. Both of these foundational devotions are ones that the Church and the Society of Jesus have offered to individuals and faith community to consecrate themselves to in order to accomplish the holy work of God in the world.

SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES FOR CANDIDATES TO A SACRED STORY COMMUNITY

- —All Candidates must take Forty Weeks—An Ignatian Path To Christ journey: completing it and the Whole-Life Confession in the first part of the journey
- —All Candidates have a regular sacramental life of week Sunday Mass and Monthly Confession
- —All Candidates begin the daily practice of the Examination of Conscience in part two of Forty Weeks
- —All Candidates agree to pray daily by name for all their fellow candidates
- —All Candidates are asked to pray a Rosary once a week



SPIRITUAL DISCIPLINES FOR A FULL MEMBER OF SACRED STORY COMMUNITY

- —Weekly Sunday Mass
- —Daily Examination of Conscience
- —Daily Mass & Communion as is possible
- —Monthly Confession
- —Monthly one-hour Eucharistic Adoration
- —Weekly Personal and/or Sacred Story Community Rosary Prayed in Common
- —Individual Consecration to the Sacred Heart and the Immaculate Heart
- -Monthly Service to Those in Need
- —Invite Fallen-Away Catholics to the Whole-Life Confession Journey
- —Commit to monthly or weekly SSC one-hour prayer/study meeting
- —Commit to guide new SCC candidates through the Forty Weeks
