

Training Programs:

Discipleship

This is a one year program designed to point students in the direction of a caring God who always shows us more grace and mercy than we deserve. Through this program, the student will gain a clearer biblical world view and a better understanding of his/her relationship and place in God's Kingdom as well as a better understanding of why we "do what we don't wish to do". Students will learn the dynamics of problems and biblical responses to those issues.

Biblical Counseling

After successfully completing the Discipleship Training Program, a student may enroll in this two year program which expands student knowledge by providing a practical "hands on" experience. This two year program is designed for those who seek a deeper relationship with the Lord, and will require in depth study of the Scriptures to gain deeper knowledge and wisdom as to the hearts of men. This training includes coursework, observation of counseling cases, mentoring opportunities, and workshops focusing on numerous case studies.

Biblical Counselor Certificate

After completing the DTP and BMTP, a student may apply for this one year intensive <u>Internship</u> which provides additional "hands on" experience in the areas of counseling and mentoring.
