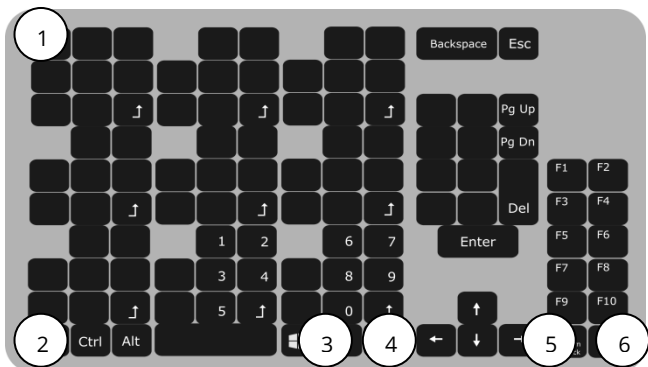


Know Your Keyboard



	Description	Key
1,4	Join/Virama/Halant	
2	Combination/Shift	
3	Function/Fn	
5	Num Lock*	Fn + F11
6	Language Switch**	Fn + F12

*Toggle Num Lock to switch between native numbers and English numbers.

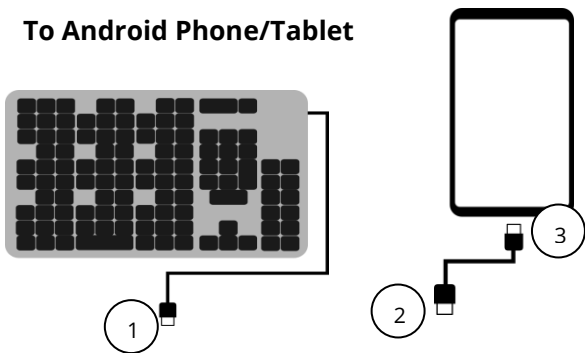
** Language Switch works on Windows, Linux and Android. For macOS, a configuration in settings is required.

Note: If numbers are appearing in English, turn off Num Lock.

Connecting Your Keyboard

To Computer – Plug-in the cable to USB port on your computer.

To Android Phone/Tablet



Use USB-to-OTG connector to plug-in keyboard.

Language and Layout

You can use one keyboard to type multiple languages. You need to install at least one language to type.

Language	Layout
Bengali Assamese	Ka-Naada Bengali Keyboard
Devanagari Sanskrit Hindi Marathi Neapli	Ka-Naada Hindi Keyboard
English	Ka-Naada English Keyboard
Guajarati	Ka-Naada Guajarati Keyboard
Kannada	Ka-Naada Kannada Keyboard
Malayalam Tulu	Ka-Naada Malayalam Keyboard
Odiya	Ka-Naada Odiya Keyboard
Panjabi	Ka-Naada Gurmukhi Keyboard
Telugu	Ka-Naada Telugu Keyboard

Note: You need to switch to Ka-Naada input language before typing.

Note: To switch between the languages you're using, repeatedly press **Language Switch** key to cycle through all your installed languages.

Language Pack Installation

Go to <https://ka-naada.com/downloads/> and click on the "**Download**" button in front of your operating system.

Installation – Windows

1. Open your "**Downloads**" folder and locate "**kanaada_keyboards.zip**".
2. Right click on zip file and choose "**Extract Here**" from the option menu.
3. Double click on "**KaNaadaInstaller.exe**" to run easy installation process.

- a. Choose your languages in the list and click on **“Install”** button.
- b. Click on **“Yes”** button in the security warning dialog. **This may take up to a minute to show.** It is safe to install Ka-Naada input languages.
- c. Click on **“Close”** button in the installation dialog to continue installation of other languages.

Note: You need to repeat step **b** and **c** for each selected languages.

Installation - macOS

1. Double click on **“ka-naada.dmg”** to run
2. Run **“Keyboard Installer”** app
3. Drag **“ka-naada.bundle”** and drop on app to install.

- a. Open "**System Preferences**", choose "**Keyboard**".
- b. Switch to "**Input Sources**" tab, click on "+" icon bellow Language list box.
- c. Search using "**Ka-Naada**" keyword to list all Ka-Naada input languages.
- d. Choose the right option and click on "**Add**" button.

Note: You need to repeat step **b**, **c** and **d** to add another language.

Installation - Linux

Check "**Read Me.txt**" provided in zip for installation procedure.
