

# TROUBLESHOOTING and LOCATING-Online Course Code 1514

## I. Course Cost and Policy

*TROUBLESHOOTING and LOCATING-Online*, Course Code 1514 is a “self pacing” online training course. It is approved by TCEQ as an 8 hour CEU credit for Landscape Irrigator, Tech or Irrigation Inspector (LIOL license program).

To enroll in the course, the cost is \$150 *plus* sales tax.

\$150 + \$12 (estimated sales tax) = **\$162** total

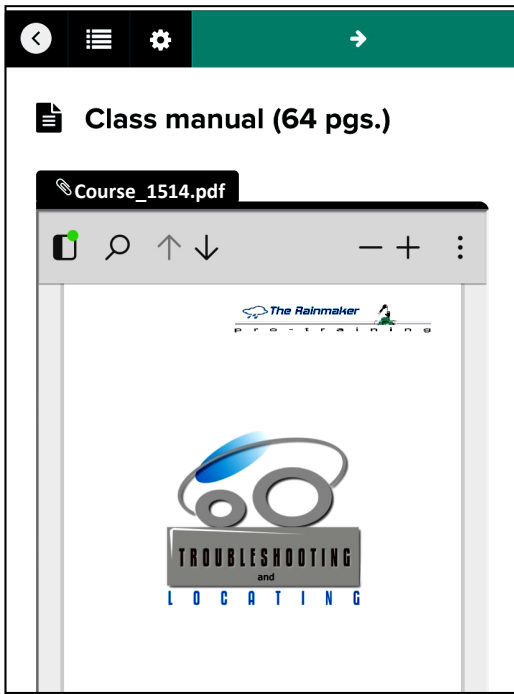

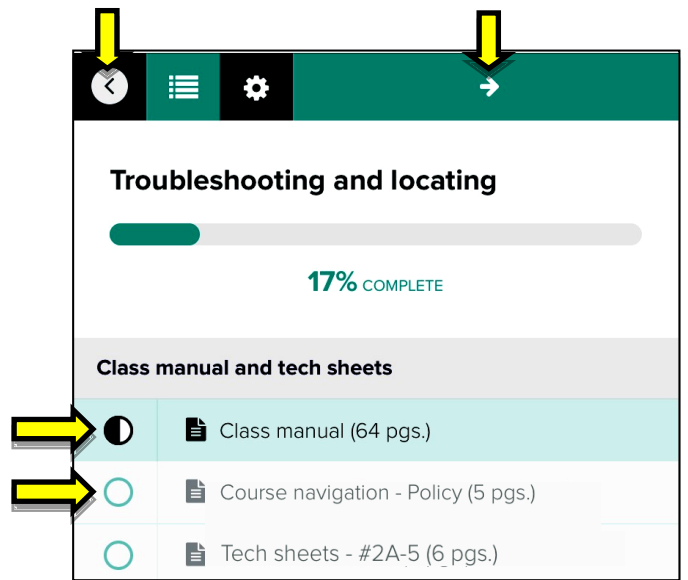

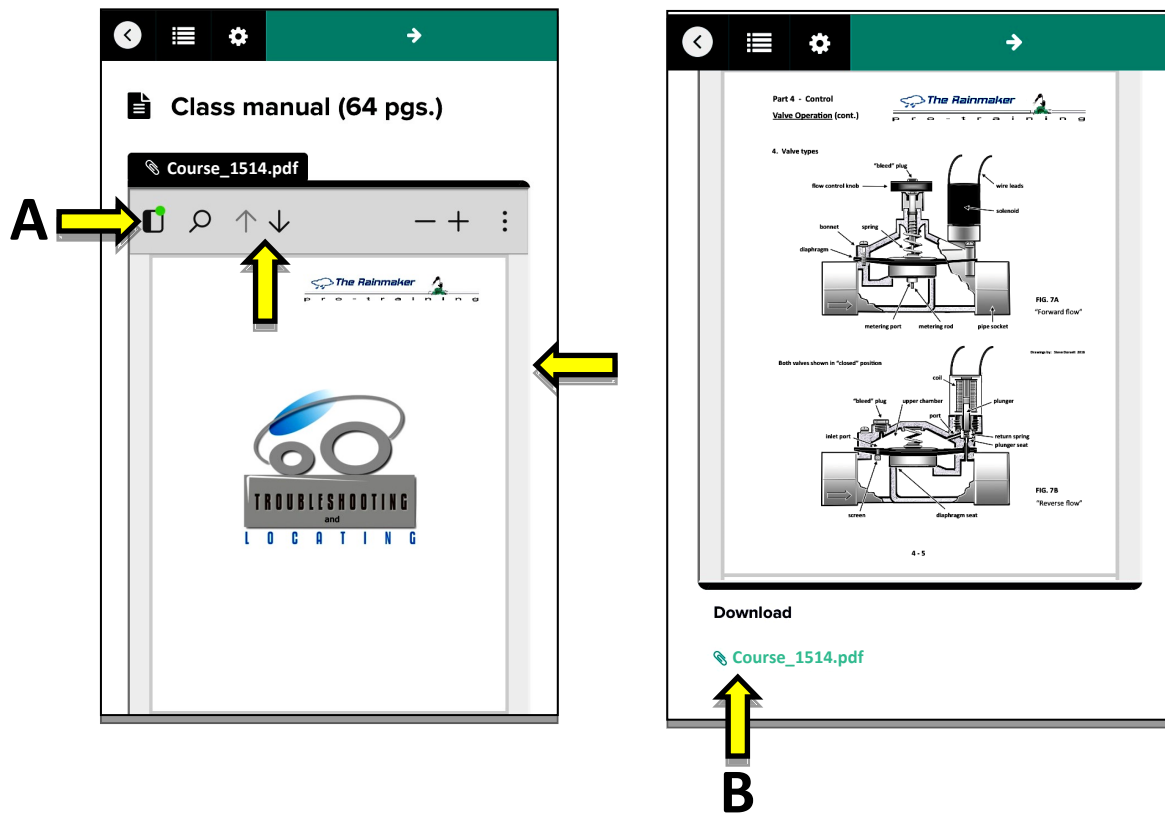
When a module has been completed, you can use the arrows to review a previous module or advance to the next.

### III. File viewing and download

At the start of the course will be reference material that will be beneficial to the student. This includes the class manual, a course overview, course navigation and tech sheets.



This material can be viewed or saved to your computer. The file format is PDF. Your computer will need *Adobe acrobat reader* installed to view these files.

You can view the contents of a file by using the toggle side bar on the top left (A), the slide bar on the right, or you can toggle between the pages by using the up or down arrows at the top.

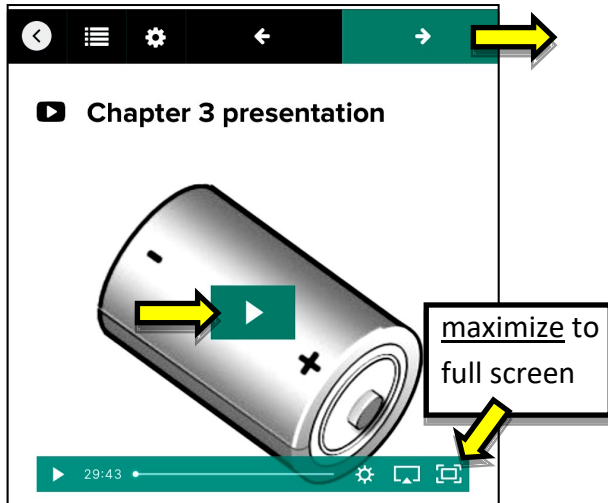
To download a file to your computer: scroll the site window to the bottom and click on the file (B). This will open it as a new tab where you can choose a folder destination for it in your computer.

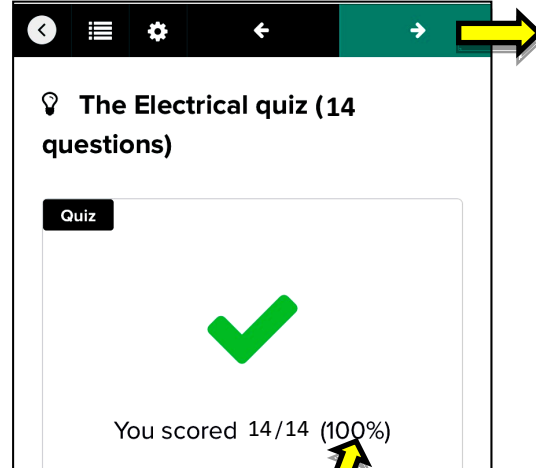
### IV. Student Course Navigation-B

#### Watch video

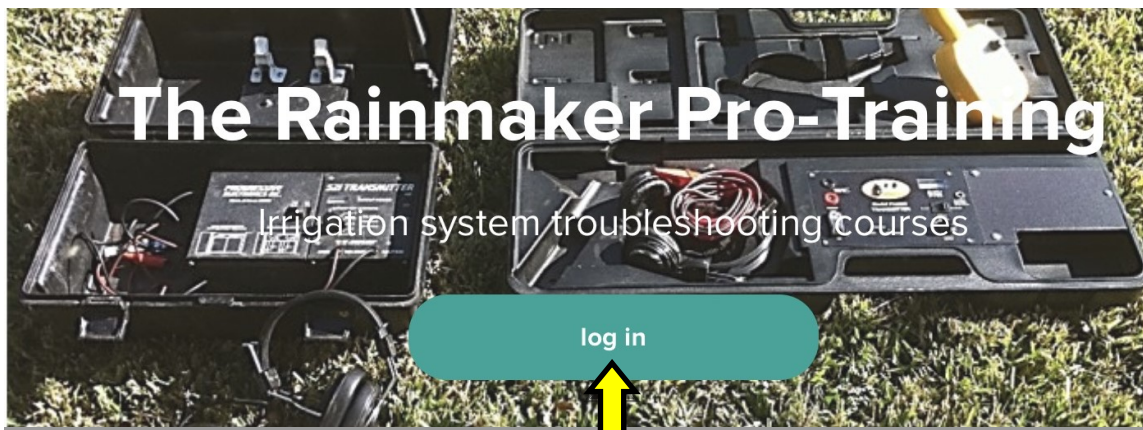


Video must be watched in entirety before you can proceed to quiz. **Don't fast forward.** This will prevent the navigation arrows from activating. Should this happen, restart the video from the beginning and let it play out.

#### Take quiz and advance



Minimum score of 70% is required. If you don't pass a quiz, you can reset it and take it again.



#### Student Course Log-in/ Log-out

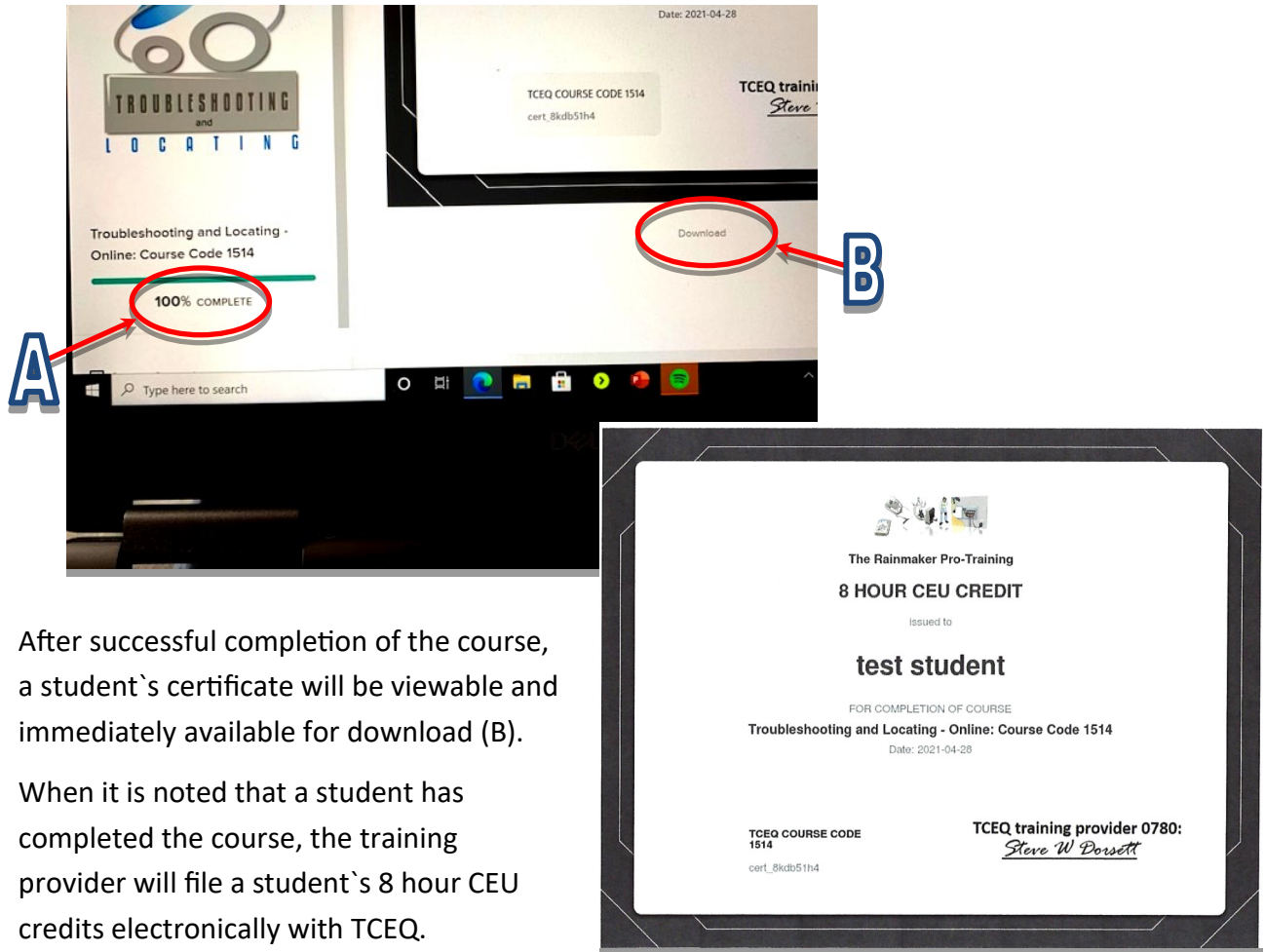
An enrolled student has a school account and unique passcode.

You can stop and then return to the course anytime at your convenience.

A video or quiz will resume where you left off.

### V. Course Completion and Certificate



After successful completion of the course, a student`s certificate will be viewable and immediately available for download (B).

When it is noted that a student has completed the course, the training provider will file a student`s 8 hour CEU credits electronically with TCEQ.

Irrigation in Texas is regulated by the TCEQ - Texas Commission on Environmental quality. TCEQ approves CEU (continuing education unit) training courses and the training providers.

Troubleshooting and Locating-Online is a "self pacing" online CEU course. This course is accessible without an instructor and can be taken at the desired pace or convenience of the user.

TCEQ rules require that CEUs earned by a *single* "self pacing" on-line training course code can not be repeated during the same 3 year (irrigator, tech or inspector) renewal period. However, a *different* self-pacing on-line course code can be taken, and credited during that same renewal period. CEU credits can be repeated for a single *attendance* type course code during the license holder`s 3- year renewal period.
