Father God,

Prayer Devotional Action Steps

Commune ~ Fellowship with Your Good and Faithful Father

Because Faith in God's Word REALLY does come by hearing, reading and focusing on God's Word (Romans 10:17)... and God's Word is CRITICAL to your prayer working successfully, **these Instructions are a vital component to you receiving your answered prayers.**

- ✚ **Read** the prayer for basic understanding and write down the 1st thing that comes to you. **EXPECT** your Good and Faithful Father to speak to you. You ARE His sheep... and you do hear His voice. **John 10:27**
- ✚ **Read** the scriptures several times, meditate on/think about them throughout the day... and write down additional thoughts. Again, **EXPECT** your Good and Faithful Father to speak to you.
- ✚ **Repeat** this process as often as you can for as long as it takes - **until you "sense confidence"**... meaning that you have a "sense" that it's true, when you think or say your MAIN POINT from the prayer to yourself.
- ✚ **Now PRAY** the prayer with confidence – which is **with faith in what God has said**, and continually praise Him for this truth.

FYI – this prayer is written so that you can

- ✚ Say It
- ✚ Confess It
- ✚ Declare It
- ✚ Thank and praise God with it
...as often as you'd like or need!

This process continually strengthens your faith and keeps His goodness flowing in your life.
