

Walk in the Park

Your students will love exploring the “park” as they are challenged to find animals that live there.

Activity Type: Movement

3 Things They Learn:

- Awareness of Environment
- Printer Awareness
- Vocabulary

What You Need:

- Pictures of animals laminated (cat, dog, squirrel, bird)
- Walk in the Park audio recording

What You Do:

- Before circle time, place the pictures around the room without the children knowing.
- At circle time, introduce the song and explain that you will be taking a walk around the “park” to meet the different animals that live there.
- Turn on the music and as a class, walk around the room using the recording as a guide.
- Encourage the children to copy the sound of each animal after hearing it on the recording.
