



## **Memorial Pencil Portrait**

### Supplies list

#### Recommended for growing artists:

- 2 sheets of artist's drawing paper (any brand marked "artist/professional grade" will do).
- Printed copy of reference photo in black and white (see lesson for instructions)
- Drawing pencil - 2B or 4B
- Blending stick (AKA blending stump or tortillion)
- Eraser with a sharp edge or fine tip
- Tape - removable masking
- Fixative spray (Krylon Gallery Series Fine Art Fixatif is a fair-priced brand)

#### For beginner/budget artists:

- 2 sheets of white printer paper
- Printed copy of reference photo in black and white (see lesson for instructions)
- Any pencil (#2 school pencil, mechanical lead)
- Piece of newspaper or tissue for blending
- Pink school eraser that's not too worn down on it's edges
- Tape (Removable masking tape is preferred to not damage your drawing paper, but in a pinch you can take a piece of clear Scotch tape and place it sticky-side down on a fabric surface a few times. The lint it accumulates will keep the tape from sticking too well to your drawing.)
