Use the following scales to assess your 5th grader's final "A Lasting Impression" project.

Objective #1: Content. Artwork demonstrates inspiration from the Impressionist art movement and artist Claude Monet through the illustration of a personally meaningful landscape; short, visible, and quickly-painted brushstrokes; 2-4 uniquely mixed colors in each main section of the landscape; and presence of both light and dark colors.

Objective #2: Creativity. Artwork demonstrates creativity through choice of landscape, color mixing, and paint application.

Objective #3: Composition. Artwork demonstrates excellent composition through the filling of the page with paint and landscape design.
