## Occupational Therapy Continuing Education Professional Development Units Information

It is the responsibility of the participant/course registrant to determine whether their state approves CEU's for this course. Kathe Wallace has offered this information as guidance with the caveat that all needs to be confirmed by the licensee. ## COURSES THAT ARE NOT SPONSORED BY AN AOTA APPROVED PROVIDER

According to the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT)

Courses that are **not** sponsored/completed with an AOTA approved provider (e.g. courses taught by Kathe Wallace on Teachable) **are accepted** where 1 contact hour (not to include meals or breaks) = 1 unit. Kathe Wallace Teachable courses are approved by California State Physical Therapy Association (and more) therefore should qualify under the below criteria.

Attend workshops, seminars, lectures, professional conferences, or online courses that are approved by one of the following: Regionally accredited college/ A certificate of attendance or a letter university from the sponsor/employer verifying State regulatory board for contact hours or CEU, dates, event title, 20 1 hour = 1 unit 36 units licensure renewal attendee name and workshop agenda Continuing-education providers (if available). Please do not submit sign-(e.g., state associations, in sheets as they will not be accepted. continuing-education companies) Third party entity The same workshop may be claimed only once for PDU per renewal cycle.
