Keep the colors of a pretty template from influencing your design decisions by desaturating the layers.

Problem:

Pretty colors in templates can inspire you, but they can also keep you from seeing the full potential of using the template with the photos in your stash.

Solution:

Desaturate the colors in the template to start with a neutral palette.

How to Desaturate a Layer

- In the Layers panel, click on a colored template layer to activate it.
- Press Shift Ctrl U (Mac: Shift Cmd U) to desaturate the layer.
- Repeat.
