



## Supply List for Scroll Sketching

This is a general list of items that can be used through the process of making your segments and assembling them together. Please note the process of making the segments will be personal for each creative that makes them so they will not look the same or will they look like mine. It's impossible especially when you start intuitively creating the conversation you can carry on in your own mind and heart will be the guide. I so have a handout though just in case.

- Paint brushes, large and small
- Acrylic paints, artist, or craft quality
- Small spray bottle for water
- Water container
- 1 tub of baby wipes
- 1 roll of paper towels
- 10 paper plates, for palette
- \*\*Optional, some not all-aqua pencils, Wax water-soluble crayons, pastels, colored pencils, charcoal pencils etc.
- Ephemeral-buttons, ribbons, small bits of material, small beads, sticks, feathers etc.
- Allow collage and found papers to make their way as your materials to use.
- Thread-thicker or thinner, Waxed-Optional
- Needles-small and larger with points-Crewel needles work great
- Watercolor paper 140lb. Hot press (4) sheets 14 x 18
- Jar of Soft Gel Medium, PVA, Tacky etc.
- Jar of Gesso 8oz.
- Scissors
- Ruler
- Exacto Knife
- Large zip lock bag-to house all your papers and supplies in.
- 1 days' work of newspaper-use as an underlayment or workstation.
- Plastic dollar store table covering, to protect you work area surface.
- Found papers, old books and found photo's resale shops have them
- If you have sewing machine, you can use that too.



Of course, there are have's or don't with the materials you can use. The best is to explore with what you have. Making a Scroll Roll can be any length, from 2 ft to 10 ft. The more segments you have to roll the more interesting the Scroll Roll Sculpture will be.
