

after he dies, the kingdom will be split.





The Northern Kingdom has 20 different kings (20 evil kings), and eventually, the kingdom is defeated by Assyria in 722 B.C.

The Divided Kingdom of Israel
1 Kings 15-16; 2 Kings 8-25; 2 Chronicles
10-36:21 | Southern Kingdom (2 tribes)

The Southern Kingdom has 20 different kings (8 good kings and 12 evil kings), and is eventually defeated by Babylon in 586 B.C.
