Unlocking 1514 High Frequency Verbs From Al-Quran - Form 1.1

In this list there are 22 high frequency verbs that are repeated in Al-Quran collectively for 1514 times. These verbs are in the Form 1.1 فَعُلَ عَنْ وَاللَّهُ group where the verb only has 3 root letters without any additional letter, and the second root letter, which is the ain (عُ) of the word is fathah, stroke above (عُ) in al-madhi, past tense, and dhommah (عُ) in al-mudhari'e, present tense. Note that the harakah, or stroke, for al-amr, command tense follows that of mudharie.
