USING THE TEACHABLE DASHBOARD (Practical lesson 4)

HOW TO EMBED A VIDEO IN YOUR COURSE

- 1. Choose your course and go to "curriculum" on the dashboard.
- 2. Click on "Add New Lecture" and write a title befitting the video that you intend to add e.g. "Jesus on the Cross."
- 3. Add text instructing the students to watch the video, e.g. "Please watch the video below about Jesus on the Cross."
- **4.** You can either add a video from your computer or embed a video from the internet e.g. From YouTube.

Embedding a video from YouTube.

- **5.** Choose the video that you want to embed in your course and hit the share button.
- **6.** You will see many options of sharing to various social media platforms like Facebook, Twitter, Reddit etc. and an "**embed**" option (with two arrows facing opposite directions)
- 7. Click on the "embed" option and copy the long code (link), appearing below the words "Embed Video," on the side of the video.
- **8.** Go back to your course, where you want to add the video.
- **9.** On the instructions panel next to the dashboard, click on "**Add Custom Code**" and a black screen will appear.
- 10. Click within the black screen and paste the code that you copied from YouTube, earlier.
- 11. Click on the Add Custom Code button, below the black screen, to embed your video
- **12.** Click on the "**Preview**" button on the top right of your screen to see how the embedded video looks in your course.
