

Chant for Maryam

This is one of the oldest chants among the followers of Yeshua, original sung in Aramaic ... and one that celebrates union with the Eternal Masculine.

Though originally written for Maryam, Yeshua's mother, this portion of the chant speaks beautifully to Magdalene ... who was favored by Yeshua, Son of GOD, and blessed with the LORD's presence.

In fact, that phrase 'The LORD is with you' is a beautiful ancient way of saying two things: 1) that Maryam knew how to receive the penetration of Adonai (Hebrew term for LORD, the Eternal Masculine) and ... 2) that He was WITH her. In the ancient Hebrew (pre-Jewish) tradition, the presence of the LORD was the most desired experience in life!

I invite you to sing this chant over yourself ... that you too will be blessed with the loving penetration of the Divine Masculine, and will feel His loving presence WITH you at all times.

Consider replacing Maryam with your own name.

Shlom lech Maryam.

Hail Mary,

Malyat tayboot.
Full of grace,

Moran a'mech.
The LORD is with you.
