

Oral language development has been one of the BIGGEST success stories for our kids and we are excited to celebrate this journey with you and your kids!


Together!

Every year, we chose to push aside other learning activities to concentrate on oral language development for 2-3 months.

You will want to find space in your child's day to practice reading their piece aloud (5-10 minutes), memorizing their selection (10-20 minutes), and practicing their piece (5-30 minutes)

To get the full benefit of this development program, you will need to dedicate 30-60 minutes about 3-5 times per week.

This is, BY FAR, one of the best with activities we ever enjoyed with our kids in our homeschool journey.

Seeing them live with a selected piece of literature for months, craft an interpretation of the story, build confidence as they stand in front of a room and present the story, and experiencing the growth in their speaking skills was profound.

Prayerfully decide to go all in with this development and we are confident your kids will grow.


COMPETITION Details

Our time will end with an online competition where your students can showcase their skills and compete.

- Students will select literature that can be presented as an oral interpretation.
- Selection should be age appropriate and suitable for a community audience.
- Text may be deleted to meet time requirements, but no text may be added.
- Student will not use props or costumes.
- Student may use appropriate and natural gestures to demonstrate characters or story.
- Student must remain standing.

Time: Minimum 3 minutes, maximum 5 minutes.

- 1. Time begins with first utterance.
- 2. Student will state title and author (not anonymous) at beginning of presentation.
- 3. Student does NOT say their name or age.
- 4. Piece must be memorized.
- 5. No prompting or directing from audience





IMAGINE your child's confidence sky-rocketing.

What would their future hold if they are confident speaking in front of others, poised, and articulate?

Speaking skills do not happen by a dusting of fairy dust; they are absorbed through practice in a safe environment where kids are given training, skills, and safety to practice and practice again.

Over time, confidence grows and becomes a part of their communication DNA.
