**CANVAS:** 'Go Large' if you want- I used a 30" x 40" x 1.5" deep, stretched-canvas

MEDIUM: Golden Fluid Matte Medium- small or medium size bottle

**PAINTS-HEAVY BODY:** I love using the Golden Modern Theory Heavy Body Paint Set and highly recommend purchasing it online at Dick Blick or Jerry's Art Arama. This is a really great set and absolutely the most inexpensive way to get into heavy body professional quality paints- and has a bonus -the set includes a color chart that shows how-to mix the eight paint tubes of colors to

make just about any color you want- including my extras.

EXTRA HEAVY BODY ACRYLIC PAINT COLORS USED IN THE SPRING COURSE:

HEAVY BODY ACRYLIC: (not in the Modern Theory Set) I use in this course: I have a few favorites: Cobalt Violet Hue Medium Magenta, Cadmium Yellow Deep, Green Gold and Quinacridone Red (this color makes the best pinks when mixed with white).

EXTRA GOLDEN FLUID ACRYLIC COLORS USED IN THE SPRING COURSE: Carbon Black and Iridescent Copper (Fine) I love Fluid Paints! I include an article on them at the bottom of this Supply List, please scan through it if you want to know why I prefer Fluid in certain situations. I almost always use Carbon Black FLUID Acrylic for my black 'go to' paint: for instance, I used it to apply the color to stencil the canvas.

\*PLEASE NOTE: All the EXTRA PAINT COLORS are my most favorite 'go to' colors I usually add to my Modern Theory Paint Set, but please know you *can* mix these colors using the Modern Theory Paint Set paints and the color chart (included in paint set).
