Quick Reference Guide

1. Add an image to a 12x12 document.
2. Duplicate the original image and apply the Stamp filter.
3. Select and erase the white pixels.
4. Select, contract (2px), and erase the black pixels.
5. Duplicate the original image and apply the Palette Knife filter.
6. Add a black layer mask and paint in color using the Watercolor Light Opacity brush.
7. Add a white layer mask to the stamp layer and remove excess border lines with a Hard Round brush.
8. (optional) Duplicate the Palette Knife layer and change the Blend Mode to Screen. Reduce the Opacity of the Stamp layer.
