Painted by: Jan van Eyck in 1434

Materials and Technique: oil on an oak panel

**Interesting Fact:** This portrait features Giovanni di Nicolao and his wife. It is often thought by modern viewers that she is pregnant, but actually she is holding up her full-skirted dress, as was the fashion at that time.



## Lucca Madonna

**Painted by:** Jan van Eyck circa 1437-1438 **Materials and Technique:** oil on panel

**Interesting Fact:** The lions on the arms of the throne in the picture are a reference to the throne of King Solomon.

**When:** 1440

Materials and Technique: oil, wood
