- User has the flexibility to change the shape color, size, font based on his preference.




Change the SmartArt Format

- Click on SmartArt Design from the Menu bar and select the option based on your choice




Change of SmartArt Layout

- Click on SmartArt Design from the Menu bar and select the option Right to Left




Move the content of SmartArt



Go to Insert and Select Shapes




To edit shape Right click on the shape and select Edit Points.
