## Really?

= when you show surprise or interest in what the other person is saying

"I went to New York last year."
"Really?"

#### What's it like?

= when you ask for a description

"I live in Oxford."
"Really? What's it like?"

# On holiday

= when you relax and don't work or study

"Are you going on holiday this year?"

# just

= only

"She's just here for a week."

## A couple of

= two (sometimes three)

"I'm here for a couple of weeks."

# That sounds (+ adjective)

= when you give your opinion

"We want to tour Australia next year."

"That sounds fantastic!"

#### That's nice

= a positive comment when you don't know what else to say

"My neighbours gave me a lovely plant."

"That's nice!"

### I hope so

when you reply to a question about the future and say you want something to happen

"Do you think you'll pass the exam?"
"I hope so!"

# I hope not

= when you reply to a question about the future and say you don't want something to happen

"Are you working this Sunday?"
"I hope not!"

# That isn't long

= when a period of time is short

"We've got 50 minutes to write a 600word essay."

"That isn't long!"

## That sounds a long time

= when you think that a period of tme is long

"It took me two hours to get home yesterday."

"That sounds a long time."

#### There isn't time

= when you don't have time to do something

"There isn't time to go shopping before the plane leaves."
