

Online Privacy, Anonymity, Pseudonymity



Online Privacy is the level of privacy protection a person has while connected to the Internet.

- Involves the right of personal privacy concerning the storing, repurposing, providing to third parties, and displaying of a person's information online.



Online Anonymity is the means of blocking any tracking or tracing of a person's identity while on the Internet.

- The goal is to remain anonymous while on the Internet, i.e., hackers.



Online Pseudonymity is a near online anonymous state where a person uses a pseudonym (a fictitious name) on various websites.

- Commonly used on social media and forums to hide a person's real identity.
