When you asked Jesus into your life...


- ➤ Pain was turned to joy.

Day 1: Remember, It's a personal relationship

Being a "new" born again Christian was an exciting time for me in my adult life. Being new in Christ gave me the desire to get to know him personally more and more.

I read His word to get to know Him better, prayed for guidance and joined a Church family to gain this personal relationship with him. I taught Sunday school and sang in the choir. And I wanted to become a part of his *Tribe*.

During my journey I learned that in order to witness to others, you must have a personal relationship with him. This is the only way it works. It has to come from the heart...

Some Christians don't quite understand, however God just wants you to have complete faith in Him and Him alone. You must submit to His will and not your own. You must never forget who you are and to whom you belong.



Day 1: Remember You belong to Jesus

"Brothers and sisters, I want to call your attention to the good news that I preached to you, which you also received and in which you stand. 2 You are being saved through it if you hold on to the message I preached to you, unless somehow you believed it for nothing. 3 I passed on to you as most important what I also received: Christ died for our sins in line with the scriptures, 4 he was buried, and he rose on the third day in line with the scriptures." 1 Corinthians 15:1-4

This is the theme and the background of your faith. <u>Believing that Christ died and arose again</u> for your sins is the reason why you do what you do. No, you are not perfect however through your ups and downs it's the only way to become an effective witness to others.

"Because if you confess with your mouth "Jesus is Lord" and in your heart you have faith that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. 10 Trusting with the heart leads to righteousness, and confessing with the mouth leads to salvation." Romans 10:9-10
