I create a Master file folder on my computer called: **Passion4Paper**.

Then inside that folder, I create a folder for each Section.

The file folder naming I use looks like this: **01-PFP-WorkingWithColor**

Let me break the name down:

01-PFP-WorkingWithColor

01- Section

PFP- Class Name

Working with Color - Section Name

Or another way to look at it:

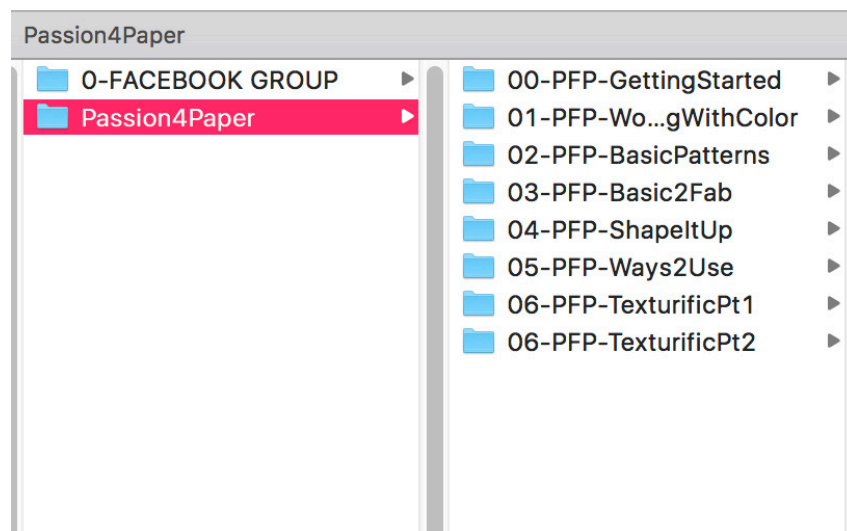
Section-ClassName-SectionName

The only exception is the Getting Started and Pre-Class sections. I've created a folder named:

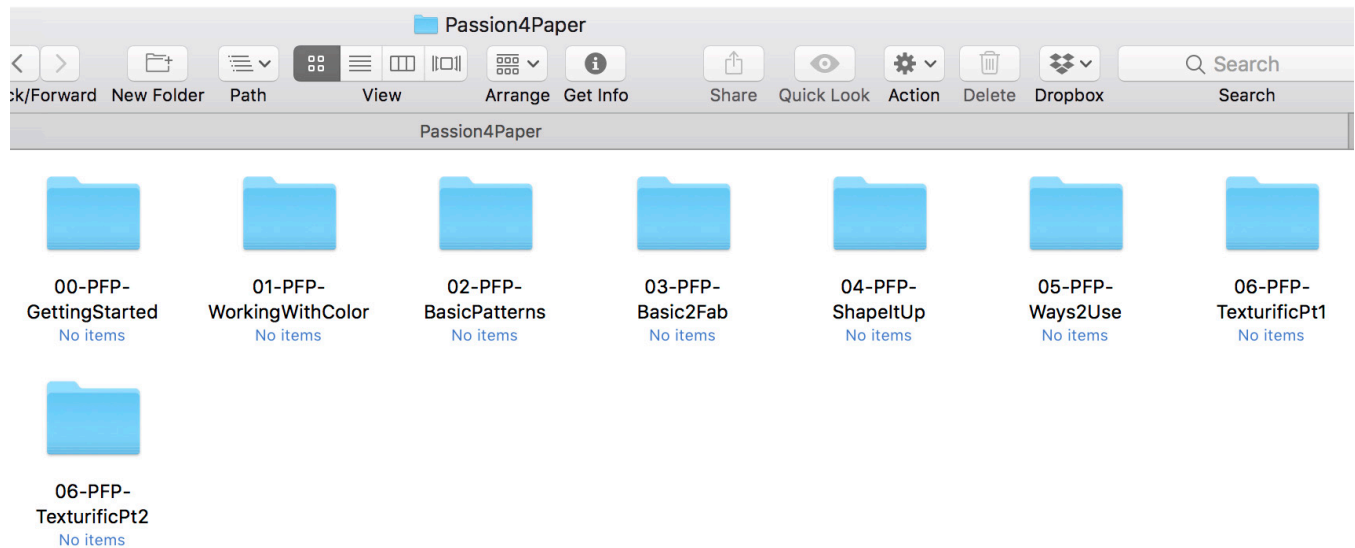
00-PFP-GettingStarted

I also include the Installing Your Class Brushes from the Pre-Class section in this file since it really doesn't need it's own folder.

List view:

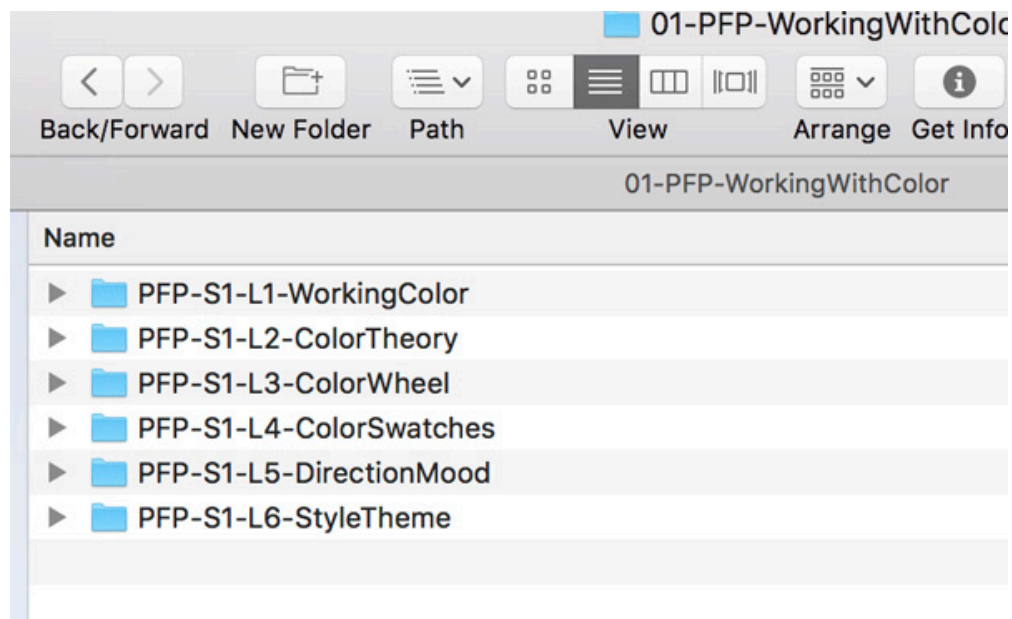


Thumbnail view:



Inside the Section folder I create a folder for each Lesson. These are named so that they correspond with the file names of the videos and manuals.

For example inside the 01-PFP-WorkingWithColor folder looks like this:

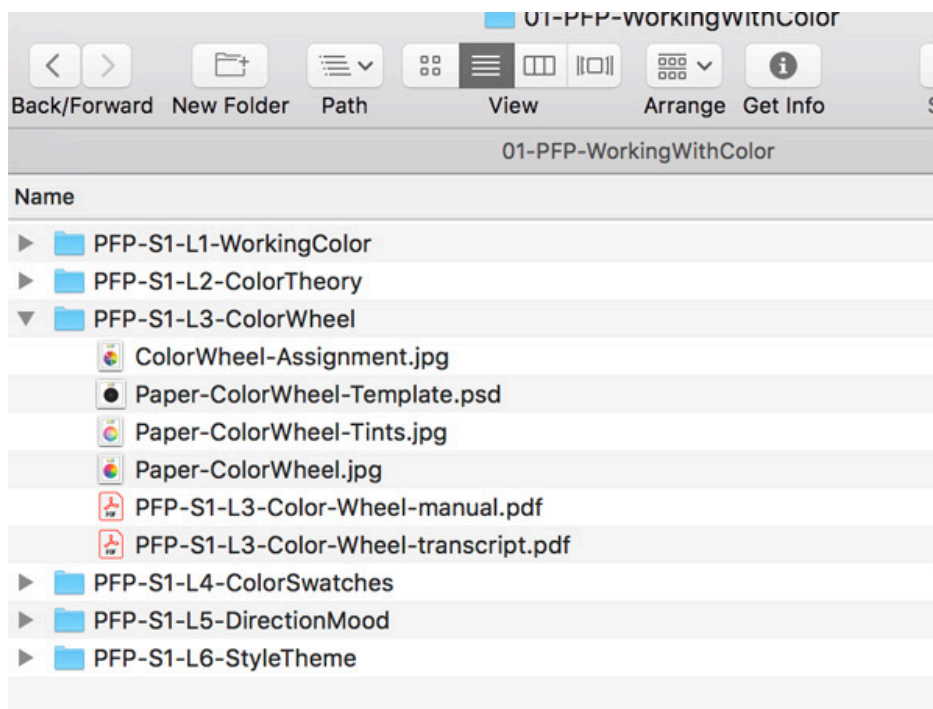


Inside each Lesson folder I keep:

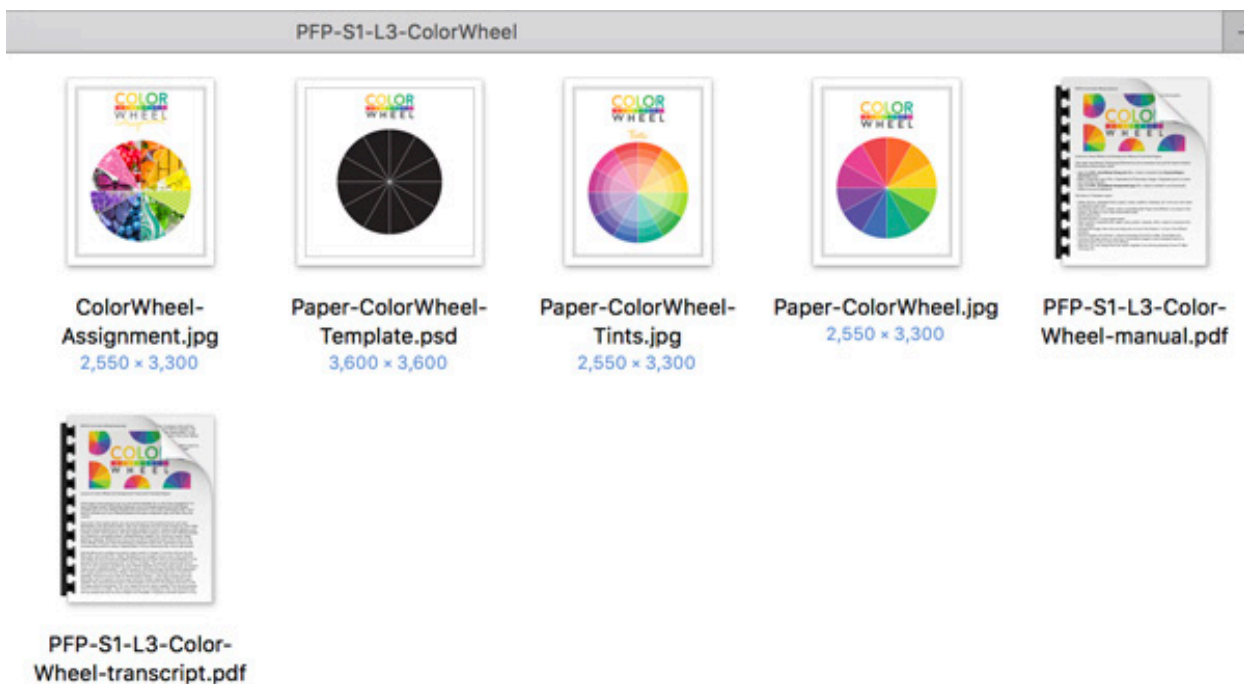
- Manuals

- Anything relevant to that lesson

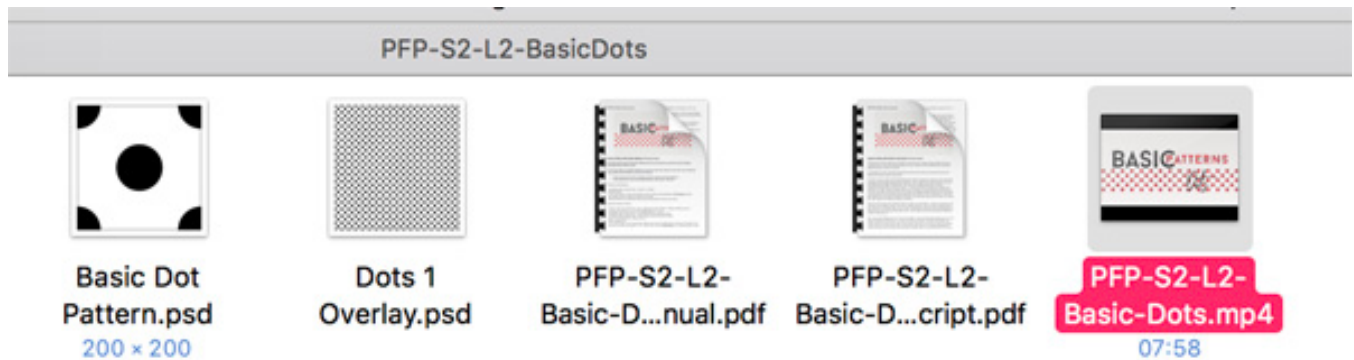

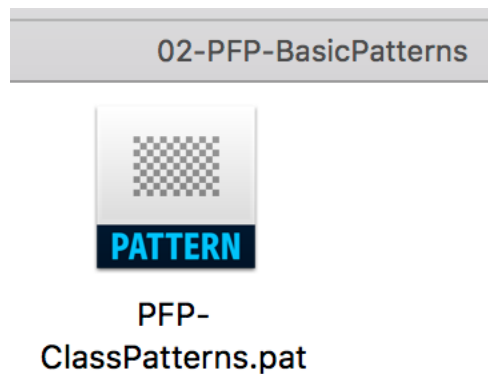
Thumbnail view:
