

35- קמרת - רבן שמעון

One who reads the section of Ketoras daily with kavana, will be saved from having any pain or sorrow all day. Zohar I, 218.

36- קמרת - תניא רבי נתן

If man would realize how much HaKodosh Baruch Hu cherishes the portion of Ketores, he would take each letter of it and put it on his head as a golden crown. Zohar I, 218.

37- קמרת - תניא בר קפרא

Ketoras provides an atonement for Loshon Hara spoken in private - Talmud Zevachin 88b

38- אָנָּא נְבִיחָ

This prayer consists of 7 lines which symbolize the way Hashem runs the world. 6 words on each line represent the 6 wings of the Angels. (Seraphin)

39- רבון העולמים

During the Temple times simply bringing a korban wouldn't help. First one had to ask forgiveness. This shows how important it is to daven. Radak-Hosea 14:3.

On Shabbos -40

This offering was brought only after entering the land of Israel. Two additional sheep were brought symbolizing the Remembering and Keeping, the Shabbos holy!

On Rosh Chodesh -41

The verse says festival in plural to include all 12 months not just Rosh Chodesh Nissan, which is the head of the months (the beginning of the year).

On Rosh Chodesh add Psalm 104 -42

Recall the merit of our forefathers: Avraham the bull, when he ran after a choice calf (for his guests). Yitzchak the ram, (agreeing) to be tied to the alter and Yaakov the sheep, separating the lambs (for his wages).
