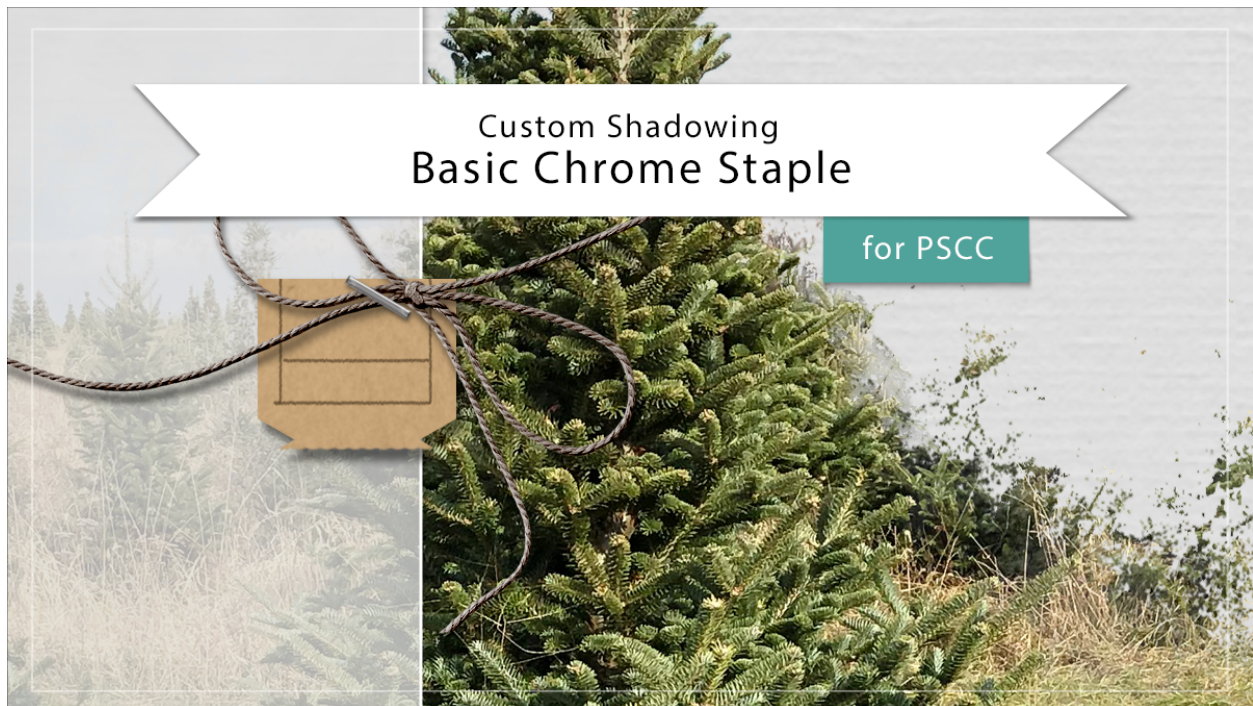

- Begin in Adobe Photoshop.
- Open the scrapbook page (File > Open) that you created in this class.

Create a Custom Shadow

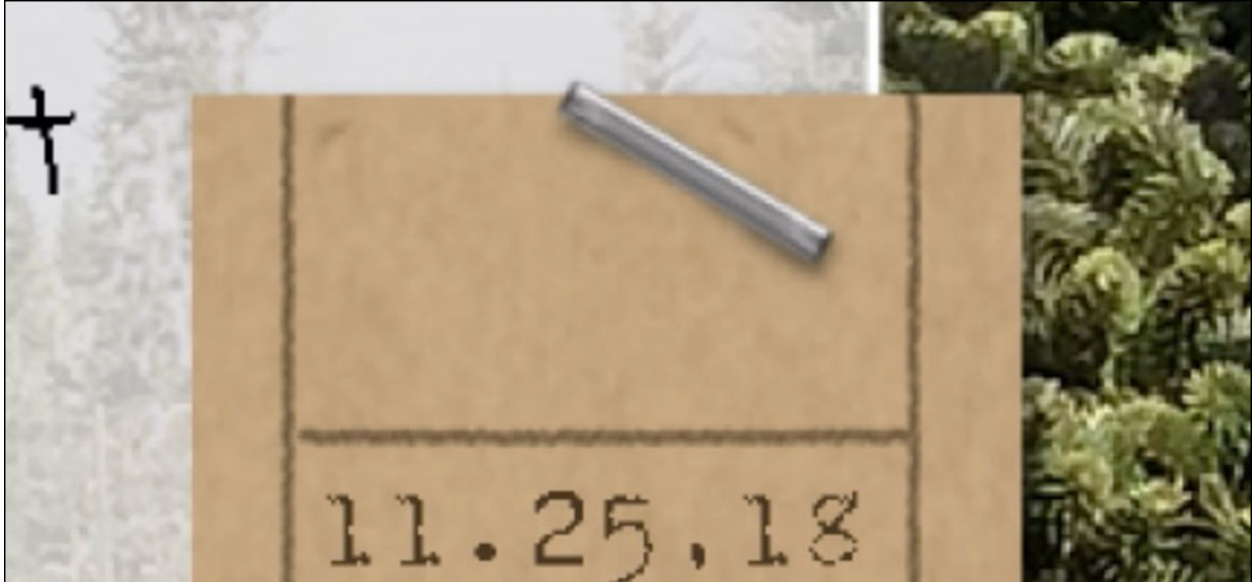
- On the document, hold down the letter Z and click on the staple several times to zoom into it.
- In the Layers panel, click on the Basic Chrome Staple group to activate it.
- Click on the arrow to twirl open the group.
- Right click (Mac: Ctrl click) on the Effects icon of the staple layer and choose Create Layer.
- Click on the Drop Shadow layer to activate it.

Smudge the Shadow

- Get the Smudge tool.
- In the Options Bar, open the Brush Picker and choose a Soft Round brush from the

Legacy Brushes > Default Brushes. Set the Mode to Normal and the Strength to 50%.

- In the Brush panel, set the Spacing to 25%.
- On the document, hover your cursor over the staple so that you can see the outline of the brush. Press the Right or the Left bracket key to resize the brush so that it's about half the size of the staple.
- Slightly click and drag the middle section of the shadow up under the staple.
- Slightly click and drag the ends of the shadow down and to the right.



- In the Layers panel, click on the arrow to close the group.
- Save the scrapbook page (File > Save).
