This tip is amazing for:

- working with lengthy, destructive actions.
- starting over with scrapbook pages.

Quick Tips for the History Panel:

- To open the History panel, in the Menu Bar, choose Window > History.
- If you use the History panel often, I'd recommend docking it with your other panels.
- Click on the topmost image in the History panel to reset your document to the state it was in when you first opened it.

This tip works even if you've:

- surpassed the number History States set in Preferences.
- created history snapshots.
- previously saved your document.

This tip does not work if you've closed the document and reopened it.
