

An Instruction for Priests Hearing The Whole-Life Confessions

The experience of hearing confessions that have been well- prepared and offer so much of an individual's personal lives: hopes, struggles, dreams, fears, sins etc., is powerful and consoling for the priests. Try to find that sweet spot (not too little—not too much) in spending time in your pastoral comments and offering of the penance and absolution. Not all be said. Ask the Holy Spirit to guide you on what to say and how much to comment on.
