Why Declarations?

Home Encounter

Focus: The Imagination

When we want to encounter God, we go somewhere quiet without distraction, which includes turning off the phone, and relax in His presence. Then we want to practice using our imagination (which was given to us by God) to connect with Him as a friend.

Practice imagining that Jesus sits down next to you wherever you are. He smiles at you. You can see the love and acceptance in His eyes. He only sees the good in you. You can tell from His smile and gaze on you that His love for you is deep. No one has ever loved you this completely. He says to you, "I have been waiting all day to connect with you." What do you say in response?

You can also express Psalm 27:4 in your own words: Jesus, if I could boil it down, all the things I need and all the things I want, this is what matters most. I have one desire: to be in Your presence and see You for who You are.
