Papers

- Large selection of lightweight papers such as tissue, and dressmaking pattern paper, in neutral shades.
- Large piece of white paper / card to use as background when photographing plants.
- Baking paper
- A4 copier paper
- Sandpaper

- Scraps of ephemera such as handwritten letters, documents, botanical images
