- Begin in Adobe Photoshop.
- Open the scrapbook page (File > Open) that you created in this class.

Create a Shadow Layer

- In the Layers panel, click on the top Handmade Paper Polaroid Frame group to activate it.
- Click on the arrow of that group to twirl it open.
- Click on the Effects dropdown arrow of the Frame layer to open the effects applied.
- Click and drag the Bevel style temporarily to another layer or group that does not currently contain an effect.
- Right click (Mac: Ctrl click) on the Drop Shadow effect of the Frame layer and choose Create Layer.
- Click and drag the Bevel effect back onto the Frame layer.
- Click on the new Drop Shadow layer to activate it.

Smudge the Shadow

- Get the Smudge tool.
- In the Options Bar, set the Mode to Normal, the Size to 400 px, and the Strength to 50%. Uncheck Sample All Layers and Finger Painting. Open the Brush Picker and choose a Soft Round brush from the Legacy > Default brushes.
- Press Ctrl + (Mac: Cmd +) to zoom into the frame. To reposition the zoom, hold down the Space bar and click and drag on the document.
- On the document, slightly click and drag to smudge the shadow of the frame. To change the size of the brush on the fly, press the Right or Left Bracket key.



Save

- In the Layers panel, close the frame group.
 Save the document (File > Save).
