Welcome to Egypt

We pray that this week of fellowship with the Father, Jesus Christ, and with each other brings unspeakable joy, complete joy, and true joy.

Our aspiration for sports leaders and teams can be summed up by Ephesians 4:13 (NIV): "... until we all reach unity in the faith and in the knowledge of the Son of God and become mature, attaining to the whole measure of the fullness of Christ."

Chapter 4 emphasises the collective over the individual. In the NIV translation, "we" is repeated four times, "body" five times, "one another" twice, "each other" once. In v11, Paul tells us that lesus gave gifts. The purpose of the gifts is made clear in v12 and in v13. Paul tells us about the desired outcome for how the gifts will serve to equip and build up. Paul includes himself when he says "... until we all ...". None of us are perfect. None of us have arrived. We are on a journey of maturing. We need much grace for this. Many in the world of sport have begun this journey, and many more still need to embark on this journey. Since 2019, we have wrestled with the question of – How to multiply the number of mature and maturing sports leaders and teams 10X in a postpandemic era?

Our current season (2019-2024) focuses on the "athletes" (sports leaders and teams) who are in the "race". The "race" we run is of making disciples in all nations for Christ in the world of sports, play and fitness. Our nine Heart Values and The Way That We Serve (ethos) unite us across 236 countries, islands, and territories. The ReadySetGO strategy and library developed between 2012-2019, helps us to envision, and to equip sports leaders and teams to make disciple-makers who make disciple-makers for the work of Going to All People, Places and Sports (GAPPS). The desired outcome is to see mature and maturing sports leaders and teams develop and multiply to reach the GAPPS so "... the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the LORD as the waters cover the sea." (Habakkuk 2:14)





What encourages us to dream big?

God's grace over decades of sustainable culture and values through mature leadership residing in the Nominating Team, Support Team, and Global Strategy Team.

What is the vision?

The sports movement in 5,000 cities by 2033.

How do we get there?

By increasing the disciple-making workforce of mature leaders and multiplying teams through 1,000 Multiply Schools worldwide. Using sports movement models, curriculum, and expertise, we will invite other global, regional, and local partners to own and run their own Multiply Schools. Multiply Schools grow the expansion of GOSports, GOPlay, GOFitness, GOAllAbilities, and all present and future strategic programs. The Multiply Schools are unique as they serve all strategic programs. As modelled in Kinshasa they also provide our best opportunity to have all participants be from key large population cities who work toward serving all communities in the large population cities.

What do we hope to see as the outcomes?

1,000,000 leaders, whole-life sports coaches, and families on a mission to make disciples who multiply disciples, teams, and churches.



Mature Leaders and multiplying teams

The leadership development approach is from the grassroots to the global level. The most crucial part is the multiplication and development toward mature local leaders and teams in every community, city, and country. There are 12 Big Region Teams that listen to the needs and opportunities of cities and countries to develop an execution plan. 50+ regional representatives and specialists form the Global Strategy Team. They are equipped and supported by city or country multiplying teams and movement mentors.

The movement remains resilient despite global pandemics, regional wars and natural disasters. Certain things have changed. Certain things have not. We continue to run the Ready Set Go "race" of making disciples in all nations for Christ.

In our current season the focus is on the "athletes" (sports leaders and teams) who are in the "race". The desired outcome is to see mature sports leaders and teams develop and multiply. Mature sports leaders and teams who are deep will go wide. Mature sports leaders and teams who go wide will in turn go deeper.

What is the solution to improve the endurance and performance of athletes to win the race to claim the reward? One of the solutions is sports leadership training. In the sports movement, high ownership in cocreating training, and empowering local disciple makers to deliver this training in an optimal way for their culture, is a core value and top priority. Since 2015, over the last few years this enabled the sports movement to deliver leadership training to about 80,000 volunteers annually, averaging 30 leaders per training session in 45 cities each week.

Another solution or "meal plan" to provide leadership development nourishment is Multiply Schools. After thousands of leaders undergo 3-5 day Ready Set Go training sessions yearly, 1% of highly selected leaders are invited to a 21-day Multiply School intensive program. Today, there are 60 schools around the world for each time zone. This list is growing every year.

We continue to run the Ready Set Go "race" of making disciples in all nations for Christ



What is the purporse of GOsport


Jesus commanded us to GO and make disciples in all nations. We are focused on GOing to make disciples in the world sport... that is what GOsport is:

GOsport is disciple-making in the world of sport.

What is the GOsport PATTERN for sustainable disciple-making?

Here is our ideal pattern of play: CHRISTIAN SPORTS PEOPLE (disciplemaker athlete or coach) sharing the gospel with NON CHRISTIAN SPORTSPEOPLE praying that they will turn to Jesus, as they do this they are being supported by a LOCAL LEADER (Equipper) who in turn is being supported by a SUPPORT TEAM (Mentors)

Support Teams and Local Leaders are also making disciples of sportspeople (especially when there are no Christians in the sports clubs today!) And they are look to FIND, CONNECT, SUPPORT other Christian sportspeople to do the same.



What is the GOsport global PLAN?

We facilitate collaboration between GOsport support teams (mentors) and leaders (equippers) around the world to:

1 Go to the GAPPS in sports around the world

FIND and CONNECT more Christian Elite and competitive sportspeople (all involved in the world of sport) and help build an established disciple-making for Competitive and Elite sportspeople in every country/city.

2 Collaborate on the development of RESOURCES and STRATEGIES that serve to make disciples in sport.

Develop further 3 GOsport STRATEGIES (Sports Camps, Academies, & Sports Mentoring ((formerly chaplaincy)) Build specialised meal plans for all three strategies.

Update the Sports Stadium RESOURCES to serve the Christian athlete and coach.

3 Develop LEADERS in sport through specialised meal plans

To develop LEADERS together from every BR through the meal plan for the 4 people groups of the pattern of play and the training and the resources that go with them.

To provide ongoing mentoring for LEADERS in GOsport so as to build established models and co-learning.

GO ActionSport

Target Audience

Leaders who are making disciples of Jesus in every action sport in every nation.

We work with our audience by:

- Gathering leaders at regional and global summits as well as over regular zoom calls in 5 regions of the world.
- Developing personal relationships of trust and collaboration where we can share resources, learn and partner to make disciples.
- We meet monthly on Zoom in addition to the summits and regular calls listed above. Our team spends time connecting leaders in various ways.



What are your goals for the next year or so?

- Gather 500 leaders from 80 partner organizations/200 teams in 50 nations
- 5 Regional Summits
- Japan Global Summit Feb 2024

GO AllAbility

Description of GO Team

The GO All Ability Team's vision is to bring ALL to God's Kingdom by including all people with disabilities in and through sports ministry. Our team comprises of 11 dedicated team members from 6 Big Regions representing different categories of disabilities and various All Ability regional ministries, coordinated and led by Niel Louw from South Africa.

Target Audience

We work with the local church and its leaders, as well as sports ministry leaders with the heart to engage and include people with disabilities (PWDs) in their vision. We also engage with people with disabilities worldwide, as well as those involved in works with PWDs in and through sport, play and fitness. This includes elite athletes, participants of sports/games of all levels, coaches, team managers, administrative/technical officials, etc.

We work with our audience by:

- Equipping ministry leaders through our Level 1 and Level 2 training courses, as well as providing ministry practitioners with the supply of specialist equipment for adaptive sport and play.
- Having outreaches/chaplaincy at major All Ability sport events to serve, equip and encourage participants.
- Seeking expertise, resources & partnership with individuals while assisting them in their spiritual growth and leadership journey through prayer, Bible studies, training opportunities and reaching them with the Gospel message and love of Jesus Christ.

Our core activities as a GO Team

- Relationship-building as a growing team and getting feedback on All Ability ministry events on regional and big regional level.
- Planning and strategizing training events and all ministry opportunities and invitations.
- Encouraging and praying for one another and serving each other as team members.

Goals

- Increased funding for the distribution of adaptive sporting equipment (e.g., audible balls/boccia sets) to be used in training and allocated to trainees for their own ministry plans.
- Level 1 and 2 All Ability Training in Big Regions where no trainings were done. This includes leading and facilitating the launch of All Ability Teams in those regions.
- Follow-up visits and/or online engagements with leaders trained in 2022 (North America, Europe, NAME, Eurasia etc.).
- Creating an All Ability ministry "Starting Guideline" to be used globally following the training of leaders in Big Regions.

GO Play

Target Audience

GO Play focuses on children, teens, families, and communities – and is therefore open to all, seeking to creatively include people. The power of the language of sport and play connected to the community.

We work with our audiences by:

In the past decade we have had competent training resources for raising leaders who specifically work with children and teens. This has been our big focus. These are as relevant as ever. Last few years we started to be more intentional working with families and encouraging family discipleship.

- Listening to the local strategies, bringing to global to contextualize and providing to all to use in an open source environment.
- Preparing relevant training tools to be used everywhere.
- Building capacity in the leaders and teams to look and listen, be creative and facilitate relevantly.
- Empower teams to implement, adapt or create new strategies depending on the opportunities.
- Training and involving young leaders to join the facilitation team.

What are your goals?

- Keep being innovative by developing new training tools, strategies through FlashLabs or similar strategies.
- Going after GAPPS.
- Keep serving the movement, especially BRś, Multiply Schools, ISLS, with a curriculum standard that also gives freedom to be relevant in each situation.

GO Fitness

Target Audience

- Health and fitness professionals that are believers.
- Christian health and fitness enthusiasts that put an emphasis on regularly training the body, mind, and spirit.
- Churches and individuals interested in leveraging fitness as a disciple-making tool to create missional communities.

We work with our audiences and use strategies such as:

- Providing training in health and fitness, how to use it as a disciple making tool.
- Supporting the BRs to form GOFitness teams that can work catalytically.
- Creating pathways and support for the disciple makers and leaders so they can grow in their calling.
- Providing training at the local level and capacity building opportunities through world showcases.
- Building Communities of Practice where people can learn from each other.
- Sharing best practices with people in our network.



What are your core activities as a GO team?

- To develop strategies and resources designed to help all who come in contact with gaming culture and to help the gamer take their next steps in their walk with Jesus.
- Support gamers and their family / community.
- Video game tournaments.
- Providing resources for coaches and competitive players, guidance for lay leaders interested in reaching gamers.
- Live streaming and Discord community creation.

Description of the Team

We are gathering a small part of our team so we can work on a strategic plan that will target many aspects of our challenges and opportunities.

Target audience

We want to serve/reach the non-English speaking world. Our desire is to serve our countries and what is happening around us with the resources in our heart language.

Core Activities as Go team

To translate as many resources as possible so all of our GO teams can use the many resources that have been created in the sports movement.



Goals for the Translation Strategy Team:

- Find and translate resources into new languages that are spoken by more than 10 million people.
- Increase multiplication (how to promote and deliver resources to GAPPS and locally in our regions.
- Implement these resources in trainings / Multiply School (prioritizing what is most needed for specific regions / languages).

How can you help us find and grow our team?

When we translate for the movement, we go beyond the language!! We need to carry the "heart of the movement", the right terminology, and the heart of the message. For this reason, not just anyone can translate but the ones that will faithfully carry the message! To be able to grow our team we really need your help. We are considering local trainings, Multiply Schools, and ISLS to find possible champions that will rise and join the translation team! For this to happen, we need everyone to understand how important translation is!

TREMMCAR

Overview

The sport movement has spent much of the last decade creating ReadySetGO resources and now we are in a season to multiply mature leaders and multiplying teams. Resources catalyze and spread strategies. High quality open-source resources that reflect our values in the hands of competent leaders will support multiplying leaders and teams.

We need mature and multiplying leaders and teams to make disciples for Jesus. Resources and strategies are needed to:

- 1. Further create the leader development journeys to help develop leaders in focused areas of sports discipling. Eg All Abilities, Competitive sports people, H&F or Families on Mission.
- 2. There needs to be more emphasis beyond training events using the eight TREMMCAR elements embedded in maturing of leaders.


Defining each dimension and role

One of the key reasons for creating Core Resources is to provide essential equipping for each leadership role/dimension. Each role/dimension has distinctive needs. The resources will need to reflect this and will try to find the best ideas to help each person develop in their maturity and impact in their role and stage of growth.

We defined three clear roles/dimensions of leaders from Ephesians 4. The disciple maker (everyone), the equippers (apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers), and the mentors (Paul).

We all begin as disciples and disciple makers. As God opens opportunities for us to be equippers and then mentors, we never graduate from disciple making. Disciple making is the foundation of the equipper's role and the mentor's role.

Each role also has a key task to perform in relation to their team/teams. The disciple maker principally starts teams, the equipper grows teams, and the mentor multiplies teams.



MULTIPLY SCHOOL CARIBBEAN



English Speaking Multiply School in Barbados - 2022 & 2023 Combined Results

- 15 participants representing 15 distinct churches/para-church organizations
- Almost 50/50 split between males/females
- 2023 Ministry Plans 3 Sports Academies, 1 Fitness Club, and 3 Kids Games

"When we get the right people that are passionate about sports and passionate about Jesus, we get long term commitments."

A great successes has been watching participants emerge as key leaders within their own networks A great example is Thonny who came to the Multiply School held in Dominica in 2016. In 2023, when we added a second Multiply School in Haiti, Thonny became the leader of that Multiply School. It was incredible!



French Speaking Multiply School in Haiti - 2023

- 24 participants in the first year.
- 22 men, 2 women
- Representing 18 cities 15 churches & 4 para-church ministries
- 22 ministry plans completed potentially birthing 9 new ministries and 4 new teams
- 22 graduates from Multiply School (2 participants had to leave for emergencies)

One participant who should have been able to get to the location in 30 minutes went 15 hours out of the way to be safe. This new school started with 24 individuals in the context of conflict, major issues in government, gangs, kidnapping, lots of killing happening on the streets.

"We had two leaders, who could have left, but they just kept saying, "no, we can stay, we can work. We believe God has called us here." This one act of obedience could changed the future of Haiti forever! "

Multiply School puts you in an environment where the expectation of servant leadership is modeled for every student. You are challenged not only intellectually, but your heart, your character, your thought processes are revolutionized by what you hear, what you see, and what you feel.

"Our goal is to see the multiply school become the premier incubator for training christian leaders and disciple makers in the Caribbean, not just in sports but in every area of life!"

MULTIPLY SCHOOL INDIA GOPLAY

GoPlay - using sports to bring the Gospel to entire communities.



Multiply School India GoPlay

- Focusing on strategies targeting children, youth, family and community workers.
- 35-40 participants each year 50% are highly engaged in Sports Ministry, 50% are "active"
- 42 Participants in 2022 representing 25 churches and 6 para-church ministries
- 723 Districts in India, 80 new GAPP districts reached in the last 4 years
- Since 2014, 40% of trained leaders are part of the na]onal sports ministry team, the other 60%
- are involved at some level!

In 2022, a team of 7 members from a district in India aJended the Multiply School and started implementing GOPlay Strategies in more than 100 Local churches within their denomination!

Leena, a software engineer Is now facilitating KidsGames, discipling youth, and serving in her local church after Multiply School

Wilson, a National Tennis Player, has organized GOPlay for a transgender community and seen many lives transformed by the Gospel.

Results:

- Five Sports Ministry-GOPlay Vision Casting and Training sessions are planned.
- KidsGames are planned in GAP Districts, aiming for each leader to reach 1000 children.
- Church sports are planned at 25 churches through Family Games.
- Coaching for Life is planned in 10 communities.
- One Community Cup and tournament have been planned.
- Discipleship fellowship and house cells have started in multiple cities.
- Each trained leader will mentor another leader and send them to next year's MS.

"Here in India, starting conversations with the gospel can be difficult. Using games has helped us build relationships and connect with people who may initially be closed to the Gospel."

MULTIPLY SCHOOL ETHIOPIA

The nation of Ethiopia encompasses 80 distinct languages and more than 80 individual tribes.

Multiply School Ethiopia - 2023

- 23 Students 4 female/19 male.
- 12 Churches/denominations and 4 para-church organizations represented.
- 10 Cities within 5 of 12 regions in Ethiopia.
- 7 participants plan to implement KidsGames in their churches and communities.
- 5 students plan to minister to Unreached People Groups, meeting social needs and building relationships through sports, including missions work in Eritrea and Somalia.

"I want to invest in girls in my community. They quit school and get married after grade 7 or 8." - Eyerus. She wants to see long term culture change in this Muslim community. The Ethiopia sports movement did a special training in the community. Through the faithfulness of Eyerus, they have seen a great change in the community as she continues to invest her life in the people there.

- 75% of students after 8 years are still involved in the sports movement. Almost 100% are still involved in ministry!
- 90% of graduates from 2016-2018 are still an active part of the sports movement.

Abdullah (not his real name) is from Somaliland. He wanted to share the Gospel with the Somali people. Abdullah started with a soccer ball and built relationships with students, and then started a Discovery Bible Study. He led two groups and a third online group. For his efforts, Abdullah spent 7 months in prison. While in prison, the Lord encouraged him to share the Gospel even more. Abdullah is now a key leader in this area. He continues to persevere in spite of government opposition and persecution.

As we are leading, we ask, who is the person who will take the baton from us?

John, a Multiply School graduate, was struggling to make income. We prayed over him and mentored him. He started a hiking group called "Rise Up Hiking Group." Thousands of students travel with him around the country to conquer mountains, lakes, and trails and be discipled. This group has been recognized by the government in Ethiopia.



MULTIPLY SCHOOL INDONESIA

Indonesia is the largest archipelago in the world to form a single state made up over 17,000 Islands with 350+ tribes and 750 languages

2023 Results & Statistics

- 15 participants: 4 females and 11 males.
- Representation from 7 churches and 3 para-church organizations across 5 of 7 zones.
- 14 participants completed ministry plans (1 attendee had to drop out).
- 4 ministry plans for GoPlay, focusing on discipling kids with whole life coaching.
- 7 ministry plans for GoSport, coaching in local communities.
- 1 ministry plan for GoFitness.





Leny attended Multiply School from the Island of Madura, which is 99% Muslim. She was involved in Kids' ministry and left Multiply School with a clear ministry plan. She began using GoPlay as her main strategy, gaining the trust of the Muslim community and sharing Biblical values. She has built a strong team and now serves as a facilitator for ReadySetGo.

The leaders who rise to the top have not only been through Multiply School, but they are also launching successful ministries. They are skilled practitioners of sports ministry with a deep commitment to the movement.

There are times when we judge someone too quickly, but God has other plans. Alvine, one of the participants, wanted to coach young students (kindergarten). One year after Multiply School, he is successfully coaching two groups. We may think someone is too young or inexperienced, but then we see the Holy Spirit working in their lives and their determination to implement their plan! Alvine is 17 years old.

The Indonesia Multiply School has been very successful, leveraging partnerships with local churches, The Indonesia Sports Partnership, and 5 seminaries.

Indonesia will add a second Multiply School in Sumatra in 2024! Leo, a pastor and soccer coach from Sumatra, will be the leader of the students (team trainer) for the new Multiply School. Leo went through Multiply School training during COVID. He built a team and is now seeing the multiplication of disciples. The entire Indonesian team is excited about this new opportunity!

MULTIPLY SCHOOL KINSHASA, DRC

Kinshasa, Africa's third-largest and most densely populated city, is estimated to have 20 million residents and is growing. The Multiply School focuses on Kinshasa and the 24 cities surrounding the capital.

2022 & 2023 Combined Results

- 43 participants: 9 females and 34 males.
- Representing 24 churches, 8 para-church organizations, & 5 sports federations.

"How can we transform a nation? This is our solution from God, equipping leaders through the Gospel and sports to reach people and revolutionize entire communities."

Jesus invested strategically in 12 who, in turn, raised up new leaders - this replication cycle is what we are asking God for in the DRC and across the sports movement.

Through the efforts of Multiply School, churches are beginning to understand clearly how sports can be an effective tool to reach people who are lost.

Strategic Plan for Multiply School Kinshasa

- Create partnerships with sports Federations, Clubs, and influential communities in the 24 cities/suburbs over a period of 7 years.
- Establish an effective communication and follow-up system weekly and monthly, as well as coaching and mentoring staff.
- Establish a partnership with the government through the National Ministry of Sports for national support.
- · Use media effectively.
- Impact social and community life through sports and games in each city for sustainable transformation by making disciples.

Eosse, from the first Multiply School, became the facilitator of team building for Multiply School. She started a fitness club in the city, organized a team that started a football academy, and used Discovery Bible Studies to plant a new church.



MULTIPLY SCHOOL NORTH VIETNAM

2021 & 2022 Combined Results

- 20 participants.
- 3 females and 17 males.
- Representation from 12 churches and 7 of 27 provinces in 2021.
- 3 denominations and representation from 4 of 27 provinces in 2022.


Minh returned to his province after Multiply School with a simple ministry plan. He organized a football tournament in his town. Many footballers' families are very poor. He gave gifts and shared the gospel. Tournaments were played throughout his district, culminating in a championship tournament for the province. He continued giving gifts to the poor and sharing the gospel... "Love in Action!" More than 70 people became believers!

Through diligent follow up and mentoring, we observe, evaluate, and course correct with our new graduates. We celebrate their successes and encourage them when they struggle. In our second year of Mul]ply School in 2022, 11 of 13 graduates from our 2021 school came back to help facilitate over the course of 5 weeks.

There has been significant persecution in the past few years. During one of our first tournaments, the police intervened, questioning our activities. Two leaders were arrested and later released. God showed us that partnering with community leaders, police, and governments helps them understand our intent to invest in the well-being of their city. Our governments have become more open and less hostile to sports. This approach has nearly stopped the persecution, and many breakthroughs have happened since then!

Please continue to pray Matthew 9:38 with us, that the Lord would raise up workers for the harvest in Vietnam. Josh is coordinating the Multiply School North Vietnam from over 1,400 kilometers away in Ho Chi Minh City while working a full-time job.
