

# Alternating Spike Cozy

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1. Work Round 1 in back bumps of beginning chain to create a nicer bottom edge.
2. Pattern is worked in continuous rounds, use a stitch marker to mark 1st st of each round.

## Instructions:

Ch 30, sl st to 1st ch to form a ring.

**Round 1:** Ch 1 (*counts as 1st sc*), sc in each ch around—30 sc.

**Round 2:** \*Sc in next, spike sc in next st 2 rounds below; repeat from \* around—30 sc.

**Round 3:** \*Spike sc in next st 2 rounds below, sc in next st; repeat from \* around—30 sc.

**Rounds 4-16:** Repeat Rounds 2-3 six times.  
Fasten off and weave in ends.

## Yarn

Knit Picks Comfy Worsted weight yarn (50 g/109 yds): 1 skein Silver Sage

## Materials

US Size H/8 (5.0mm) crochet hook, yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker

## Difficulty

Easy

## Size

2.75" tall, 9" circumference

## Gauge

14 sts in pattern and 22 rows = 4"

## Stitch Guide

ch(s) - chain(s), sc – single crochet, st(s) - stitch(es),  
yo – yarn over, sl st – slip stitch

## Special Stitches

**spike sc** (spike single crochet) = insert hook in st 2 rounds below, yo and pull up a loop to height of current row, yo and pull through both loops on hook.
