Alternating Spike Cozy

Yarn

Knit Picks Comfy Worsted weight yarn (50 g/109 yds): 1 skein Silver Sage

Materials

US Size H/8 (5.0mm) crochet hook, yarn needle, scissors, stitch marker

Difficulty

Easy

Size

2.75" tall, 9" circumference

Gauge

14 sts in pattern and 22 rows = 4"

Stitch Guide

ch(s) - chain(s), sc - single crochet, st(s) - stitch(es), yo - yarn over, sl st - slip stitch

Special Stitches

spike sc (spike single crochet) = insert hook in st 2 rounds below, yo and pull up a loop to height of current row, yo and pull through both loops on hook.

Notes

- 1. Work Round 1 in back bumps of beginning chain to create a nicer bottom edge.
- 2. Pattern is worked in continuous rounds, use a stitch marker to mark 1st st of each round.

Instructions:

Ch 30, sl st to 1st ch to form a ring.

Round 1: Ch 1 (counts as 1st sc), sc in each ch around -30 sc.

Round 2: *Sc in next, spike sc in next st 2 rounds below; repeat from * around—30 sc.

Round 3: *Spike sc in next st 2 rounds below, sc in next st; repeat from * around — 30 sc.

Rounds 4-16: Repeat Rounds 2-3 six times. Fasten off and weave in ends.
