If you can get from the root note to the first octave, you can repeat the same fingering to get to the 2nd and 3rd octaves and beyond. This works for all scales!

## Minor pentatonic

Formula: play root, play note 3 frets higher, slide that note up 2 frets, play note on new string 2 frets highter than root, play note 3 frets higher. Repeat.


## Major pentatonic

Formula: play root, play note 2 frets higher, slide that note up 2 frets, play note on new string 2 frets higher than root, play note 2 frets higher. Repeat.


## Major scale

Formula: play root, slide 2 frets and play note, play note 2 frets higher, play note 1 fret higher, play note on new string 2 frets highter than root, play note 2 frets higher, play note 2 frets higher than this. Repeat.


## Natural minor scale

Formula: play root, slide to note 2 frets higher, play note 1 fret higher, play note 2 frets higher. Play note on new string 2 frets highter than root, play note 1 fret higher, play note 2 frets higher. Repeat
