LESSON ONE



The student will be able to name and define the first two meditation themes for *Sacred Story*, CREATION, and PRESENCE, by giving examples from their own lives.

The students will write their reflections on CREATION and PRESENCE and an original prayer of gratitude.

LESSON ONE



Gather class together in prayer corner. Ask three students to read one of the Psalms below. (Master sheet to copy for these Psalms follow this lesson)

Prayer:

Give to the LORD the glory due his name. Bow down before the LORD's holy splendor! Psalm 29: 2

Sing to the LORD, bless his name. proclaim his salvation day after day. Psalm 96: 2

Hallelujah! Praise, you servants of the LORD, praise the name of the LORD. 2Blessed be the name of the LORD. both now and forever. Psalm 113:1-2

Close with the: "Our Father"

Introduction: Over the next school year we will be experiencing a meditation practice called *Sacred Story Youth*. *Sacred Story Youth* is inspired by St. Ignatius Loyola's "Examen". Ignatius' spirituality and discernment techniques rely on affective information to help people understand the difference between right and wrong. We are focusing on *The Name of God and my Relationship to God's Holy Name*.

Access PowerPoint to tell St. Ignatius Loyola's story to the students.

As part of the meditation Ignatius inspires five themes in *Sacred Story*. Today we will become acquainted with two of the themes: CREATION and PRESENCE.

Guided Practice

Have a student read:

I believe God created everything in love and for love. I ask for **heart-felt** knowledge of God's love **for me**, and for **gratitude** for the **general** and the **particular graces** of **this day**.

Have another student read:

God created the universe – all person and all things – in love and for love. Everything, and every person in creation is linked in Love, through Christ, in whom and for whom everything was made. We are made to reverence God and each other, and to delight in creation as both Divine gift and support for our lives. The God of All knows me personally and loves me, even before I was knit in my mother's womb. So fearfully and wonderfully made am I! (PS139:13-14)

In small groups have students name examples of their relationship with God for Creation.

Have a student read:

Independent Practice: On their own students are to use the Top Hat template.

- 1. For three minutes students are to write or draw what comes to mind in each category in your relationship with God for Creation and Presence.
- Then write prayer of praise and gratitude for the God who created the universe – the God who created it so God could be close to your heart and share God's love with you and all people.

Have students share with a partner or the whole class the prayer of praise that was written.

Closure: During our daily meditations we will reflect on:

Father, I believe You created everything out of love as a gift for me.

Jesus, I ask You to help me remember the gift in Your creation that brought

me the most faith, hope and love today.

When You help me remember, I will thank You for that gift.

And

Jesus, I believe You are present in every moment and event of my life.

I ask for a heart-felt knowledge of Your love for me.

Jesus, I ask You Jesus to help me know what my heart is feeling now.

If I am peaceful, I will tell You why. If I am sad, I will tell You why.

Illuminative Grace

I believe God is **present** in **moment** and **event** of my life, and I ask for grace to **awaken, see** and **feel** where and how God is present.


Prelude
