

1. THE FALLOPIAN TUBES & VAS DEFERENS

- 1.1. The vas deferens are a pair of excretory ducts that are designed to convey semen from the testes to the urethra. The reflexes for the seminal vesicles and vas deferens are located in the same area as the Fallopian tubes in females - across the top of the foot from one ankle bone to the other, linking the prostate and testes reflexes.
