

Baby Bee Main Activity



Today we are focusing on hand-eye coordination and our insect of the week is a bee!

Bees Love fLowers! So today's activity is to make fLowers that your baby can pick to give to the bee.

You will need:

Shoebox/polystyrene or yoghurt container

Scissors

Pine cleaners

Pipe cleaners

Material flowers

Method:

- 1. Make small holes in the lid of your shoebox or polystyrene container (big enough for pipe cleaners to fit into and stay upright)
- 2. Thread your material flowers (or homemade cardboard flowers) onto the pipe cleaners
- 3. If you are using the homemade cardboard ones, make a small hole in the middle. The material flowers should already have a hole in them.
- 4. Turn the end of the pipe pipe cleaner over so that the flower stays in place and that the end is not sharp
- 5. Now thread the flowers into the holes
- 6. Encourage your baby to 'pick the flowers' by pulling them out their holes.
- 7. Count the flowers and talk about their colours



You can also make your own cardboard flowers for which you will need:

Colour cardboard, a pen and scissors.



Older babies can be encouraged to help 'plant' the flowers again by "planting" them back into the holes.
