## **G** Blues Jam

In this jam session track, you solo, then I solo, then we trade 4s to finish the jam.

This means that I solo for 4 bars, then you solo for 4 bars, and we go back and forth from there.

Below is a chord chart, suggested chords, and a soloing device to use over this progression.

You don't have to use the devices below, you can use your own comping and soloing material, and it's there if you need it.


Have fun jamming over this G blues!

If you need some suggestions for chords and soloing options, check those out below before heading to the jam session audio/video.




## **Comping Option**
