



The Concepts of Music




There are six Concepts of Music. In alphabetical order they are:

- Duration
- Dynamics & Expressive Techniques
- Pitch
- Structure
- Texture
- Tone Colour

When you are listening to music, and are analysing it so you can then write about it, you need to have a throughout understanding of the Concepts of Music and how they relate to each other.

No one concept is more important than another, they all have a part to play and contribute to the overall sound of the music.
