



Prayer prompts are meant to serve as a springboard for your prayers. Use them to help focus your thoughts and give direction to your prayers as you meditate on God rescuing His people..

* Lord, just like the Israelites, I know that many of the hardships I face are because I've strayed from You. Help me recognize my need for rescue before I reach the point of desperation. Teach me to call on You in humility, and not only in crisis. Thank You for always hearing me when I call out to You.

* Father, when I cry out for deliverance, my human nature wants immediate answers. Help me trust Your process and timing. Give me a heart willing to obey even when I don't see the full path ahead. Let me have peace in the knowledge that You always make a way for those who walk with You.

* God, forgive me when I complain even after You've rescued me. Like the Israelites, I can be quick to forget how You've already acted in love and power on my behalf. Keep my heart from wandering back to the slavery You freed me from. Teach me to respond with gratitude, not grumbling.

* Lord, Your ways are higher than mine. Sometimes Your rescue doesn't look like what I expected—but it is always perfect. Remind me that the Red Sea path wasn't the Israelites' plan, but it was Yours and it was amazing. Help me trust You even when Your rescue comes in unfamiliar ways.

* Father, thank You for Your long-suffering love. You saw my need long before I knew it and set a plan in motion through Abraham, the prophets, and ultimately Jesus. I praise You for the gift of salvation—the permanent rescue that only You could provide.

* God, I praise You for the times You've lifted me out of the pit and set my feet on solid ground. I mess up so often, but Your Son's perfect sacrifice has made it possible for me to receive forgiveness again and again. Let me never take His sacrifice for granted. Let my life be a testimony to Your mercy and salvation.

* Lord, I know that I ask you to save me from every hardship I face. Help me to remember that You promised something greater: eternal life. Thank You for rescuing my soul, even if there are hardships in this life that I must endure. Strengthen me to tolerate earthly suffering with hope, knowing You've already secured the ultimate rescue.

* Lord, I know that You won't always take me out of the fire, but that You will join me in it. Just as You were with Daniel in the lions' den and with Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego in the fiery furnace, be with me in my trials. Use whatever hardships I face to reveal Your glory, so others may know You are the one true God.

* God, give me the strength to stand firm while I wait. Like Paul, help me keep my eyes fixed on Your heavenly kingdom even when I face persecution or hardship. Rescue me from fear and doubt, and let my faith be unshakable unto the very end.

* Father, I confess that my pride sometimes keeps me from admitting I need help. It's hard for me to admit that I can't do things myself. Break down my self-sufficiency and give me a submissive heart that is willing to surrender all to You.
